

Cell Phone Expectations

Electronic Communication Devices (ECDs) are defined as any electronic equipment that emits an audible signal, vibrates, sends and/or receives a message (voice or text) or displays a message or otherwise summons or delivers a communication to or from the possessor.

Students are not allowed to use their ECD's during the school day. Upon arrival, students are to power down their devices and put them away. Violations of this policy may result in disciplinary action, confiscation of ECDs, and/or referral to law enforcement.

The use of an ECD will result in a disciplinary action, and it will be confiscated until the next day, when it will be available for pick-up by a parent or guardian. Continued violations will be considered Refusal to Obey/Defiant. District/school officials are not responsible for the damage, loss, misuse, theft or vandalism to personal ECD's brought to school.

NOTE: If a student's behavior and actions result in a "refusal to surrender unauthorized items" to any school administrator or staff person, a Category II consequence will apply and be handled accordingly. The consequence will be an out-of-school suspension.
