What is the purpose of SCC?





The purposes of school community councils are to involve parents or guardians of students in decision making at the school level, improve the quality of education of students, prudently expend School LAND Trust Program money, and increase public awareness of school trust lands and related land policies, management of the State School Fund, and educational excellence.

Utah Code § 53A-1a-108(2) (2014)

- Student discourse and academic conversations increased for an average of 50% of time in class.
- School wide enhancement of PLC's through a systematic approach of implementation, sustainability and results driven.

4 Areas of Focus

Literacy:

By the end of June 2025, 60% of K-3 students will meet their typical, above, or well above growth goal on the EOY Acadience assessment, and all 4-6 grade students will increase in proficiency from the previous EOY (2023-2024) on the EOY RISE assessment by 5%.

Numeracy:

By the end of June 2025, 60% of K-2 students will be at or above grade level on the EOY assessments, and 60% of 3-6 students will be proficient on the EOL RISE assessment.

Science:

By the end of the 2024–25 school year, all students K-6 will demonstrate increased scientific literacy and enthusiasm for STEM subjects through regular engagement in handson, inquiry-based learning experiences.

Culture:

Attendance: By the end of 2025, our school attendance will have improved by at least 3% as compared to 2023-2024.

Teacher Wellness: By the end of the 2024-25 school year, implement wellness activities for teachers quarterly that includes mindfulness workshops, self-care activities, team building, and/or mental health information.

Family Engagement: Enhance Family Engagement and Partnerships.

Each quarter we will host at least one family engagement event.

Each month grade level teams and/or individual teachers will send one message to inform parents of what is happening in their grade level / classrooms through Parent Square.



We need to determine our committee.

The recommended composition of school community councils for other schools is four (4) parent or guardian members and two (2) employee members (including the principal). The school community council is not required to have the recommended composition and can by majority vote of a quorum of the council determine how many members the council will have, provided that there are at least two (2) school employee members and there are at least two (2) more parent or guardian members than school employee members. The number of parent or guardian members of a school community council who are not educators employed by the school district shall exceed the number of parent or guardian members who are educators employed by the school district.

Each community council shall elect a chair from its parent or guardian members and a vice chair from its parent or guardian members or school employee members other than the principal. Utah Code §53A-1a-108 (2014)
