The Board of Education (BOE) of Livonia Public Schools' (LPS) will receive sealed Bids on or before **1:00 p.m. (local time) on October 18, 2024** (Due Date) for: Summer 2025 Bond Work. The BOE will not consider or accept a Bid received after the Due Date, the date and time specified for Bid submission. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud on October 18, 2024, at 1:30 p.m. at 15125 Farmington Road, Livonia, MI 48154 or virtually via the following link: <https://tinyurl.com/LPSBidOpeningPH4BP1>

Sealed Bids must be submitted electronically through Building Connected at: <https://tinyurl.com/LPSbidsPH4BP1> on or before the Due Date. Alternatively, sealed Bids may be submitted to Phillip Francis, Asst. Supt. of LPS, at 15125 Farmington Road, Livonia, MI 48154 on or before the Due Date.

Each Bid must be accompanied by: 1) A 5% bid bond or certified check; 2) A sworn and notarized criminal background affidavit; 3) A sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner or any employee of the bidder and any member of the BOE or the Superintendent of LPS; 4) A sworn and notarized Iran Disclosure Statement; and 5) A sworn and notarized non-collusive affidavit. The BOE will not accept a Bid that does not include these sworn and notarized disclosure statements.

All proposals shall be firm for a period of sixty (60) days. Oral, telephone, fax or electronic mail bids are invalid and will not receive consideration.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at **3:00 p.m. (local time) on October 09, 2024**, starting at Churchill High School located at 8900 Newburgh Rd, Livonia, MI 48150. Please meet at the main entrance of the building. **This walk through is not mandatory, but highly recommended you will be able to visit all schools after meeting providing you make prior arrangements.**

Successful bidders whose proposals are \$50,000 or more will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance and Payment Bond in the amount of 100% of their bid. The cost of the Bond shall be included in each proposal.

The Board of Education reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, either in whole or in part; to award contract to other than the low bidder; to waive any irregularities and/or informalities; and in general, to make awards in any manner deemed to be in the best interests of the owner.
