The switch has taken effect (not without issues) but you will no longer be receiving two messages.

All school communication will be coming from School Messenger. If something seems off, please reach out to the front desk. Thank you to those who let us know that attendance calls were calling everyone you ever knew in our system... we think we have that fixed now.

If you have not already done so, you need to Opt-In to Receive Text Messages.

Text "Y" to 67587 from each wireless device you wish to receive texts on. The wireless number must be listed in PowerSchool for that student to receive messages.

If you receive a text message that says it is from SchoolMessenger (67587), it will most likely be the Opt-In message so don't ignore!

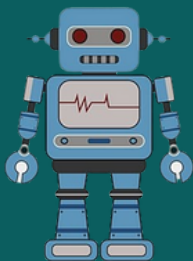

platform to get the answer,
especially during a quiz or test



Using AI to write your essays

Cheating can come in many forms and is not limited to what is listed above. Students will be caught! Consequences include (but not limited to) zero's for assignments, tests and quizzes, in-school or out-of-school suspension, even up to long-term suspension and expulsion from public schools for the remainder of the school year with no credit received for the course(s). Talk with your students about cheating and what the consequences will be. It is NOT worth it!

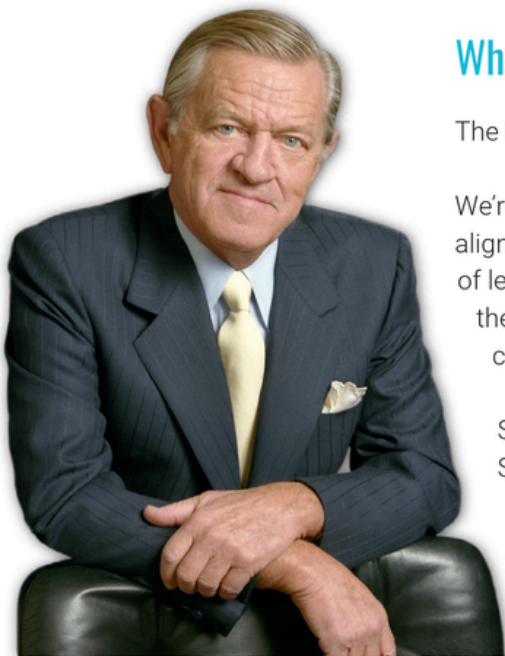


What does it mean to be a Daniels Scholar?

- Other educational expenses

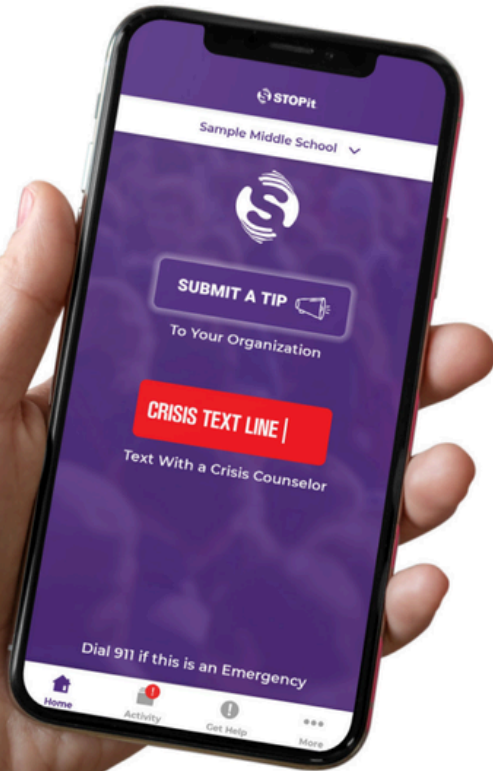
You will also receive a laptop computer and support before, during, and after college!

STOPit provides you with: An anonymous, comfortable way for you to share information so that you can provide or get help as quickly and efficiently as possible.

Use the STOPit mobile app to anonymously report incidents to your school. Reporting is completely anonymous. You can include text, images or video. It only takes a few minutes

What can you report?

- Bullying
- Cyberbullying
- Harassment
- Violence, threats, or weapons possession
- Alcohol or drug related issues
- Discrimination

How STOPit Works?

- 1 Submit a tip via mobile app, website or 24/7 phone hotline
- 2 Incident Response Center monitors and reviews your submission
- 3 School Administrators receive and act on tip submission
