When families call, email, text, or send a note, we do our best to respond within 24 hours during the work week.

Our Family-School Compacts establish the shared responsibility for student success between school, families, and students. Families and teachers work together to develop the Compacts.

- Four Seasons A+ Elementary School partners with families to create Compacts around academic goals. Compacts are available during our Open House prior to school, at fall conferences, and during our Title I Night (We Are Four Seasons). They are also posted on our website and available in our office.
- Compacts are reviewed and revised, with parent/guardian input, every spring.

Our school shares information about student achievement with families in multiple ways.

- Report cards are posted three times a year.
- Our classrooms participate in Academic Parent Teacher Teams (APTT). This means that families meet with teachers three times during the school year to look at standards, review progress, and set goals.
- Families also participate in a traditional conference (one-on-one) during March.
- In addition to report cards, teachers will report progress through various formats (APTT, Progress Reports, informal check ins) throughout the school year.

Our school supports families as advocates and provides opportunities for parent/guardian leadership.

- Regular Coffee with the Principal gatherings offer opportunities for parents/guardians to share their views and vision for Four Seasons A+.
- If parents/guardians have concerns about their child’s learning, the process at Four Seasons A+ Elementary School is to start discussion with the classroom teacher (involving MLL staff or Special Education staff as needed); after this, refer the concern to the Principal; if resolution has not been gained, next involve the Assistant Superintendent.
- The district has an Ombudsperson available to help resolve conflict between families and schools. The Ombudsperson is a person who listens to and investigates complaints against Saint Paul Public Schools, its programs, offices and staff. The Ombudsperson does not take sides. She works with parents, community members and the school district to clarify and resolve questions, concerns and complaints in a fair and timely manner. The services of the Ombudsperson are free.
