- Develop, review, and revise the home/school involvement compact when talking with parents at the annual Title 1 meeting.
- Provide assistance to parents and family members in understanding the challenging academic standards, assessments, and monitoring of a child's progress by holding annual conferences and at the Back to School Nights.
- Provide materials and training during Family Literacy Events, on ways to work with their children to improve literacy achievement and ways to use technology, including the harms of copyright piracy as appropriate. Materials will also be available in the Parent Resource Center.
- Utilize professional development sessions for teachers to share and expand upon ways staff can encourage parent and family engagement, and build ties between families and the school.
- Share with staff the results of the parent/family survey regarding best ways for the school to communicate with families.
- Host family and community literacy events through:
 - Family Literacy Events
 - Reading is Fundamental Program for first graders
 - Little Lending Library, which is open to anyone in the community
- Use digital media to share activities with families.
- Ensure information regarding programs and activities sent to parents and families through digital media, as well as hard copies of the information. When needed and possible, staff will provide translated materials or speak to the family member(s) regarding participation in their child's education.
