## SAVE THOSE STAMPS

The Sisters of Notre Dame continue to collect used and mint postage stamps and other philatelic items to help them in their ministry with the poor. Stamps with high value, first-day covers, stamp dedication programs, U.S. mint stamp sheets, album collections, U.S. mint strips and plate blocks, foreign stamps off or on paper, and other postal-related items are most desirable. ## Confession and Adoration

Tuesday, October 15th 7-8pm in the OLG C Chapel will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament with the Sacrament of Reconciliation available. This is open to the families led by Faith Formation. Feel free to stop by to spend some time with Jesus and go to confession! There will be praise and worship music as well as opportunities for silent prayer.

There will be handouts for Examination of Conscience and how to go to confession if it has been a while since you have gone to reconciliation. Parents are encouraged to go as well.

## Confirmation 2025

We are beginning preparation for an important event in your student's Christian life: the Sacrament of Confirmation! Confirmation is the time when the students commit to the promise made at their baptism and become fully initiated to the Catholic Church.

Confirmation preparation at OLG C is a two-year process. Students typically begin the process in 7th grade (Year 1) and receive this sacrament with the Bishop at OLG C in 8th grade (Year 2).

To let us know your student wants to begin the process for Confirmation, you need to register with our 1A Form. 8th graders and High Schoolers who have not begun the Year 1 process will need to complete the form as well.

Please note that you will also need to be enrolled in Catholic education in preparation for this sacrament. If your student is enrolled at OLG C School or in CCF, all you will need to do is submit the online 1A Form.
