Lee County School System Flexible Learning Days for 2024-2025

Flexible learning days are designated days when students will complete assignments from home as an alternative location to attending school in person allowing student learning to continue. These days may be scheduled for various reasons, including inclement weather or teacher professional learning.

Frequently Asked Questions for Families

1. What types of activities will students be assigned on flexible learning days?

On flexible Learning days, students will engage in asynchronous learning, completing assignments at their own pace from home. The tasks are designed to be standards-based and meaningful reinforcement of learning. No new learning will be sent home on these days.

- **Flexible Learning Day Due to Inclement Weather:**
 - **Printed Assignments:** Assignments will be sent home with students prior to the anticipated inclement weather day when possible. If advance notice cannot be given, assignments will be provided to students upon their return to school.
 - **Digital Assignments:** Due to potential power/internet outages digital material will not be assigned to students.
- **Flexible Learning Day Due to Teacher Professional Learning:**
 - **Printed Assignments:** Assignments will be supplied to students prior to the scheduled flexible learning day for students who request print materials or do not have internet access at home.
 - **Digital Assignments:** Assignments will be supplied to students through Google Classroom by 8:00 AM on the scheduled flexible learning day.

Note: *Flexible learning days for the purpose of teacher professional learning are pre-scheduled on the '24-'25 LCSS Student Calendar for Thursday, October 10th (assignments due October 21st) and Friday, February 14th (assignments due February 21st).*

2. What type of activities will students be assigned on a flexible learning day?

- **Primary/Elementary School:** Assignments should take approximately 15-30 minutes per subject
 - English Language Arts/Writing
 - Reading
 - Mathematics
 - Science and/or Social Studies
- **Middle/High School:** Assignments should take approximately 30-45 minutes per subject from the classes that are normally held on the flexible learning day (regular vs block schedule days)

3. What will teachers be doing on these days?

- **Flexible Learning Day Due to Inclement Weather:** Teachers will work on lesson planning and grading student assignments.
- **Flexible Learning Day Due to Teacher Professional Learning:** Teachers will report to school to participate in professional learning activities, collaborate with colleagues, and plan future learning for students.

4. How will student attendance be determined on flexible learning days?

Students will submit completed assignments within five school days of returning to school after the flexible learning day in order to be counted present at school for the day. This will allow students an opportunity to ask for clarification on assignments from teachers if needed.
