
Lengel utilizes a Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) structure to match support with students' needs. We strive to efficiently align supports and services and communicate with students' families to ensure their needs are being met. We also understand that students and families may have questions or need assistance but may be unsure where to direct those contacts. Students learn in many different ways, which is why it is essential to have various supports available. The following guide outlines a few of the supports available:

- Title 1 Interventionists for Math and ELA are available to assist students in the classroom and in small group through direct instruction.
- The MTSS Team reviews classroom data, interacts with teachers, and explores additional or alternate options for academic support.
- Students exhibiting behavior difficulties, experiencing stress, and/or other challenges that are impacting school function may be referred to the Student Assistance Program (SAP) where a multi-disciplinary team works to determine how to provide support.
- School counselors and a certified counselor are available to support students throughout the school day when requested by a student or referred by a staff member.
- Third-party school-based behavioral health programming is present in the school building, students and families have access to a variety of supports in a convenient setting.

If your child is experiencing behavioral or mental health concerns, or situational stressors (grief, loss, changes at home, etc.).
