Life Skills Class

At the conclusion of our CPR and First Aid unit, we had guest speaker and our very own Trainer Dr. Nicole come speak to our Life Skills classes. She reviewed with us the steps of CPR, and demonstrated for us what she does with athletes at our school in regards to first aid treatment. She showed us some of her tools and equipment as well as had us practice various first aid etiquette techniques. We all came away with some great practical CPR and first aid knowledge!

Middle School Science

The Middle School Science students have been working on a "bonding experience" in which they were forming covalent, ionic, and metallic chemical bonds. Ionic bonds are formed when two atoms exchange electrons to create



a positive and negative ion. Covalent bonds are formed when atoms share electrons to create a molecule. Metallic bonds are created when metal atoms lose their outermost electron to form positively charged ions. To gain scientific knowledge through a biblical lens deepens our understanding for God's creation and allows us to "bond" more in our relationship with Christ.

The Life Science Lab in 7th grade has been learning all about Cell Division. Cell Division is the process by which new cells are formed for growth, repair, and replacement in the body. This process includes division of the nuclear material and division of the cytoplasm. The 7th grade class was able to demonstrate cell division by using Oreos and sprinkles. What a fun project that allows the students a hands on experience all while exploring God's beautifully designed creation of cells.

High School Honors Geometry

In Honors Geometry at Bradenton Christian School, our high school students recently completed an individual project that put their geometric knowledge to the test. Each student was tasked with designing and constructing their own three-dimensional structure, applying key concepts they had learned about lines, angles, points, planes, and angle relationships. They also demonstrated their skills in geometric constructions, ensuring that their designs were precise and structurally sound.

To make the project even more exciting, we held a class competition where students voted for the best overall structure. After much consideration, Bethany Hollar and Lena Spencer were selected as the class winners for their outstanding designs. Their projects exemplified not only mathematical accuracy but also creativity and attention to detail.




Harvest Blessings Festival and Auction This is our 40th BCS Auction now with a NEW DATE of Saturday, January 11, 2025.
