#### PSAT – October 29

The PSAT will be administered to 10th & 11th graders at Klein Cain on Tuesday, October 29. This administration of the PSAT is a free, standardized test designed by the College Board. It serves as an early introduction to the SAT and helps students identify their academic strengths and areas for improvement. The online test covers reading, writing, and math, which provides a benchmark for college readiness. It also offers students a chance to practice test-taking strategies in a low-stakes environment, guiding them on their path toward future academic goals.

Current 9th grade students interested in taking the PSAT must opt-in. If you would like your 9th grade student to take the PSAT on Tuesday, October 29, please complete the 9th grade PSAT <u>Opt-in form</u> and submit no later than, Wednesday, September

25.




