Year 1 have been working super hard this week in their PE lessons. They used hula hoops to practice their balance and skipping skills. They have been testing their hand eye coordination by passing foam balls between each other.

Year 2 have been getting creative with animal print in Art. They have been cutting and sticking different patterns to create a collage.
