

What you need to know to register as a volunteer with Walton County Public Schools: Please be aware that all individuals who serve as volunteers/chaperones at Bay Creek and the WCSD are required to complete a mandatory training and background check. The link to view the training video and to apply is https://www.walton.k12.ga.us/our-district/volunteer-make-a-difference

The cost is \$11.25 and a 15 minute process to complete online.

The clearance process for school volunteers and chaperones usually takes about two weeks and the applicant should receive an email confirming their clearance. The background check approval is good for two years from approval date.

Per WCSD a school volunteer is:

A non-paid individual who serves in any auxiliary capacity under the direction and supervision of school personnel. A volunteer is one who performs any essential duties that an employee could perform such as, but not limited to, making copies, filing, escorting students, working with extracurricular activity groups or assisting with lunch duty, media center and front office tasks. Any person who leads or assists student groups or students other than their own in school or extracurricular programs is considered a volunteer.

Per WCSD a chaperone is:

Any non-school personnel who attends an off-campus school activity, whether as a parent or official chaperone.

We are hoping volunteers can assist with the following:

- Reading/Vocabulary; small groups or one on one
- Flash card drills
- Cut out lamination
- Help with arts and crafts
- Assist with sing-a-longs Help with Bulletin Boards
- Media Center/Planning Lab
- Cafeteria Monitor
- Class Projects Class Parties
- Field Trips
- Helping with homework
 Events: Book Fair, Fall Festival, Bingo Night, etc.

Please note: The following are tasks for school staff only and not volunteers. • Supervising students. Volunteers must not supervise classes.

- - · Diagnosing student needs. · Prescribing instructional programs and activities.
 - Selecting appropriate learning materials.
 - Evaluating student progress and achievement.
 Recording student grades.
 Disciplining students.
- · Evacuating students in the event of a fire or weather-related drill

Volunteers are not permitted to bring other children, including infants, or guests with them when volunteering.
