Learning Goals

Letters/Letter Sounds to Practice: This week we will learn the letters Ss, and Ii and learn the sound each letter makes (short i sound).

High Frequency Words to Practice: This week we are learning the words saw, be, he, she, me

Phonics: This week we will learn how identify rhyming words. We will blend (put together) and segment (take apart) words, and we will change word parts to make new words.

Reading: This week we will extend our learning by connecting science and reading. We will read online articles about how scientific tools can help us learn about the things around us.

Writing: This week we will learn how to edit and rewrite a story to make our writing the best it can be.

Grammar: This week we will also review naming words, or nouns and action words, or verbs.

Social Studies: Today we will learn how to describe national holidays, like Columbus Day by telling who is celebrated on Columbus Day, and when, why and how we celebrate it.

Math: This week we will learn how to compare quantities of objects by using vocabulary words like greater than, less than, or the same as/equal to.
