Vision

- Distance acuity for all newly entering students and students in Kindergarten, Grades 1, 3, 5, 7
 and 11.
- Near vision acuity and color perception screening for all newly entering students.

Hearing

Hearing screening for all newly entering students and students in Kindergarten, Grades 1, 3,
 5, 7 and 11.

Scoliosis

Scoliosis (spinal curvature) screening for girl students in Grades 5, 7., and boys grade 9

Health Appraisals

 A physical examination including Body Mass Index and Weight Status Category Information is required for all newly entering students and students in Pre-Kindergarten or Kindergarten, Grades 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11.

Dental Certificates

• A dental certificate is requested for all newly entering students and students in Kindergarten, Grades 1, 3, 5, 7,9, and 11.

A letter will be sent home if there are any findings on the screening done at school that would cause concern or need medical follow-up. Please call the school's Health Office if you have any questions or concerns.
