This report card snapshot provides significant information about student performance, class size, school safety, and teacher quality at your child's school. The report card also includes the School Performance Grade (for all schools) and the End-of-Grade Reading and Math Grades (for elementary and middle schools). These grades are calculated on a 15 point grading scale and reflect the overall performance of the schools. The School Performance Grade was calculated based on 80% overall student achievement and 20% overall student growth. The End-of-Grade Reading and Math Grades were also calculated based on 80% overall student achievement and 20% overall student growth. The information in the school report card is from the 2023-2024 school year.

As you will note from the report card, teachers and school staff are focused on improving student success. Be assured that the members of the Board of Education, central services staff and school personnel are all committed to meeting the needs of every child. We are all focused on providing rigorous programs that enable all students to be successful after they graduate from Hoke County Schools.
