You are an outstanding individual, a model student, and an embodiment of the values of Propel Schools. We know that you have a very bright future ahead of you and we are so pleased to award you this scholarship. On behalf of the Propel Scholarship Committee and Propel Schools, we wish you continued success in attaining your goals and look forward to hearing about your future achievements.*

### Scholarship Requirements

- FAST Scholars must complete at least **40 hours of volunteer service** during 3 high school years and submit the attached form signed by your supervisor.
  - For example: 40 hours during 9<sup>th</sup> grade, 40 hours during 10<sup>th</sup> grade, 40 hours during 11<sup>th</sup> grade
  - Following successful completion of high school grades 9, 10 and 11 AND 40 hours of volunteer service, FAST scholars will receive \$500 each year, for a total of \$1500 over three years.
  - Funds given during the high school years should be used to support scholar's personal growth and education (SAT prep course, tutoring, computer, summer camp, afterschool programs, etc.)
  - Propel cannot provide funds directly to scholars but can allocate funds for specific services or products on your behalf.
- Scholars are to provide an annual update to Propel Schools Foundation before a disbursement will be approved.
- FAST Scholars must complete high school in four years.
- FAST Scholars are **REQUIRED** to attend a Propel high school.
- FAST Scholars must be accepted to a four-year college or accredited post-secondary institution.
- FAST Scholars must act in accordance with the standards of Propel at all times.



## Disbursement Schedule (Total: \$16,500)

- As a FAST Scholar you will receive a \$15,000 scholarship towards a college or accredited post-secondary institution, dependent on your commitment to and fulfillment of the Scholarship Requirements listed.

Following successful completion of 9 <sup>th</sup> , 10 <sup>th</sup> and 11 <sup>th</sup> grade AND volunteer service, awardees will receive \$500 each year to be used to support their personal growth and education.
