Time in the Air Force is expressed using the 24-hour clock. Noon is 1200 Hours, 6 P.M. is 1800 Hours and Midnight is 2400 Hours. All flyers use Greenwich Mean Time, (or Universal Coordinated Time, Zulu Time), in the air. GMT, or Zulu time, is PST+8 hours or PDT+7 hours.

When saying Zulu time, use date and time. For example, 3:00pm is 1500hrs is 27/2300hrs Zulu.

Aircraft Designations: B is bomber (B-2), F is fighter (F-15), A is attack, C is cargo/transport, K is tanker, R is Reconnaissance, Q is unmanned, E is command/control, H is helicopter, P is patrol, S is strategic, T is trainer, U is intelligence gathering, V is VIP, W is weather, X is experimental. The number designator stands for the order in which the aircraft series was developed. The letter after the dash is the model number, the first starting with A.

Who/What to Salute: Officers of higher rank, American Flag outdoors, during National Anthem outdoors, reporting to an officer, when receiving an award, and always return a salute. Stand at attention: National Anthem and Pledge of Allegiance indoors. Receiving an award, remember to “Shake, Take, Salute”

Addressing Air Force Members: Airman is “Airman”, Sergeant is “Sergeant”, Chief Master Sergeant is “Chief”, Officers Lieutenant through Colonel are “Sir”, “Ma’am” or their rank, General Officers are “General”, AF JROTC Cadets are “Mister” or “Miss”

Common Commands: *Attention* (Ten-hut): Stand erect facing forward, *Parade Rest:* Stand feet apart hands crossed on back, *At Ease:* Be quiet or relax, *Rest:* Relax and talk, *Fall Out:* Depart premises, *Fall In:* Form up at designated location, *Open Ranks:* Open for inspection, dress-right-dress, *Ready Front:* Arm to side, face forward, *Dress-Right-Dress:* Left arm out head right, *Close Ranks:* Close formation, *Right/Left Face:* Turn in place 90 degrees, *About Face:* Turn 180 degrees to right, *Left/Right Step:* Move sideways 20”, *Forward March* (Harch): Left step forward 30”, *Halt:* Stop, *Right/Left Flank:* All turn at once 90 degrees, *Left/Right Oblique:* All turn 45 degrees, *Present Arms:* Hold salute, *Order Arms:* Arm to side, *Front and Center:* Leave ranks, come forward, report, *Return to Ranks:* Return to ranks, *Dismissed:* Free to go.

Folding Flag: Hold flat with union to left, fold together lengthwise with 1” blue overlap, fold again even, triangle fold starting with red/white end. Fold so flag is all blue w/ stars, tuck in end, carry with hands over chest, and flag tip pointing up.

Start of Class: All in seats prior to last bell, Call room to attention upon SASI/ASI arrival, remain standing for flag salute, “Elements report”, Elements report “Element __, all cadets present or accounted for.” or “Element __, __tardy/absent.” Flight commander makes final report, and SASI/ASI fills in attendance sheet. End of Class: “Flight attention, dismissed”.

Uniform Information: Uniform day is usually Wednesday. Default uniform is Combination 3. Uniform grades are from 100 (perfect) to 0 (poor). General knowledge and drill also graded.

If uniform not worn from 0730 to 1430hrs, or cover not worn properly, grade is “0”.

Combination 1: Blue service dress with tie, nametag, and ribbons.

Combination 2: Long sleeve blue shirt with tie.

Combination 3: Short sleeve shirt with tie.

Combination 4: Short sleeve shirt, open collar.

Combination 5: Battle dress uniform, nametags, JROTC patch, BDU cover.

Combination 6: Physical training T-shirt, shorts, sneakers, white socks, key chain.
