Details:

- * Shadow Week is offered as an opportunity to gain valuable hands-on leadership experience based on the roles of specific cadet corps positions.
- * *Freshman*, **Sophomore, and Junior** cadets will have the opportunity to shadow one of the following positions: (STC)
 - Group Commander
 - Vice Group Commander -
 - Executive Officer (2)
 - Command Chief (2)
 - Operations Commander
 - Support Commander
 - Squadron Commander (2)
 - -Flight Commander (9)

What Will This Opportunity Entail?

- * Freshman, sophomore, and junior cadets will shadow the cadet who holds each position listed above.
- * Shadow cadets will be subject to assisting, leading, and supporting alongside commanders on their decisions, actions, and proposals.

Timeline:

- * Shadow cadets should expect to follow commanders for the length of one full school week. (STC)
 - Monday (Day 1): Shadowing cadets will meet who they will be shadowing in the S-14 briefing room at lunch. At this time it would be the job of commanders to get to know their "little brother" or "little sister". i.e. Name? Goals? Personality? Hobbies? Expectations?
 - Tuesday (Day 2): Upperclassmen will continue to mentor and meet their shadow their prospective cadet at lunch in the S-14 briefing room.
 - Wednesday (Day 3): Commanders are to have their shadow partner attend a scheduled staff meeting. Both are to collaborate in order to brief the corps commanders of events, notifications, issues, etc.
 - Thursday (Day 4): Commanders are to have their shadowers complete their last leadership session and reflect on the week at lunch in the S-14 briefing room.
 - Friday (Day 5): Commanders will have their shadowers join them for a dessert celebration/graduation on behalf of the hard of work all cadets. who've participated. (STC) = Subject to Change
