





**UNIFORM:** IAW the cadet guide, AFJROTC cadets wear the Air Force uniform and have the same grooming standards as the regular Air Force (neatness, cleanliness, safety and military image). How clean is the cadet's uniform? Is it stained? Does it need to be pressed? How complete is the cadet's uniform? Deduct points based on the following guidelines.

**5 Points:**

- Untucked shirt / wrinkled shirts or pants / IPs / unbuttoned pants, shirts / gig line / off-center, misaligned name tags, ribbons, badges / etc.

**10 Points:**

- Cleanliness (stained or soiled items) / Unshined shoes / Missing cover, tie, tietab, contrails / etc.

**GROOMING:** IAW the cadet guide, AFJROTC cadets wear the Air Force uniform and have the same grooming standards as the regular Air Force. Does the cadet's hair (including facial hair) comply with regulations? Deduct points based on the following guidelines.

**5 Points:**

- Jewelry: No more than 3 rings, 1/2 inch conservative bracelets, conservative earrings

**10 Points:**

- Hairstyles: Haircut touching the ears, over the collar, touching eyebrows, uncombed, not tapered in back, unnatural hair color, etc.

- Facial hair: Unshaven or mustaches beyond corner of the lips / Beards / Goatees / Sideburns past middle of ear / etc.

**GENERAL KNOWLEDGE:** Cadets will be given one "general knowledge" question from their cadet guide or "contrails". If this question is answered incorrectly, a 5 point deduction (10 points for AS-3, AS-4 cadets) will be incurred.

**OVERALL:** Add the point deductions from each category, calculate the overall score results, and present to the instructor.

**30 Points:**

- Issue is expressly prohibited by instruction or regulation. Examples include: nose and facial piercings; non-natural hair colors or highlights; faddish hairstyles (e.g., mohawks, symbols and markings cut into hair, etc.); obscene tattoos; etc.

Finally, repeat write-ups will result in point deductions being doubled. For example, a cadet given a 10-point deduction for unshined shoes the previous week who still has unshined shoes during the current inspection will earn a 20-point deduction for that single issue.
