What Cadets Can Expect From <u>Us</u>

Expect your SASI and ASI to:

- Come prepared for class with the heart of a teacher
- Demonstrate a genuine concern for your unique circumstances
- Hold you accountable for grades and behavior (equitably)
- Only make decisions we feel are best for you, class and program
- Respect and abide by our classroom norms





What We Will Expect From <u>You</u>

We expect our student cadets to:

- Show up to (and be on time!) for all class periods
- Check school-assigned Gmail accounts daily
- Minimize distractions
 - Place cell phones on silent and out of reach
 - Don't talk while instructors are talking
- Complete and turn-in assignments on-time
- Ask questions as they arise
- Respect and abide by these norms and procedures





1. Preparation for Class

- Show to class each day prepared to learn (reading, writing, group collaboration, practical exercises, etc.)
- Participation grades will be given throughout the semester (in addition to traditional graded assessments)





2. Classroom & Instructor Presence

- Do not enter classroom without
 - Specific instructor permission or
 - An instructor present inside the classroom





3. Cell Phones & Other Distractions

- Phones should be:
 - Placed on silent (or powered off) once bell rings
 - Stowed away in book bag, purse or placed under desk until end-of-class bell
 - Left inside classroom when leaving for drill
- Airpods/earbuds will be removed inside classroom
- Hats and sunglasses are not permitted in AFJROTC rooms





4. Start & End of Class

- Everyone will be at assigned seat when bell rings
- No leaving class without SASI/ASI permission
 - MUST be on a 5-Star pass
- No gathering at door before end-of-class bell
- No leaving classroom until dismissed by Flight/CC, Flight Sergeant or Instructor





5. Uniforms

- Wear uniforms with pride and abide by cleanliness, wear and grooming standards
- Do not change out early (without instructor permission)
 - Doing so will negatively impact grade





6. Terms of Address

- Students will refer to each other as "Cadet XXXX," where XXXX is last name
- Students will refer to SASI as "Colonel," "Lt Col," or "Sir"
- Students will refer to ASI as "Master Sergeant" or "Ma'am"





7. Cleanliness of Areas & Food

- We will collectively clean up in/around our areas
 - Please hold each other accountable as necessary
- Food is not allowed inside classroom
 - <u>Exception</u>: During staff meetings or other club meetings held during lunch, food is allowed
 - Where food and drink is permitted, cadets must clean-up after themselves to ensure spaces are left clean





8. Cadet Corps Involvement

- Get involved ... take a step outside your normal comfort zone!
 - Volunteer
 - Apply for leadership positions
 - > Take promotion tests
 - Join a drill team or club
- Please get permission before signing up
 - Accurate headcounts are always helpful
 - Your word is your bond





9. AFJROTC Rooms

- S-2 ... Only for actively enrolled, reserve cadets and graduated alumni
 - Exceptions will ONLY be made by SASI and/or ASI
- S-3 ... Only for logistics staff and cadets being actively issued items
- S-14 ... Used for official club meetings
- S-15 ... Used for class, official club and/or staff meetings
- ❖ P-22 ... Used for male changing area and wellness exercises
