Why AFJROTC?

The objectives of JROTC are to educate and train high school cadets in citizenship, promote community service, instill responsibility, character, and self-discipline, and provide instruction in air and space fundamentals.

The AFJROTC program is grounded in the Air Force core values of integrity first, service before self, and excellence in all we do. The curriculum emphasizes the Air Force heritage and traditions, the development of flight, applied flight sciences, military aerospace policies, and space exploration.

Curriculum opportunities include:

- Academic studies
- Character education
- Life skills education
- Leadership opportunities
- Team-building experiences
- Intramural competition
- Field trips / training opportunities

AFJROTC at Temecula Valley High School (TVHS) is a four-year program. The curriculum includes Aerospace Science (AS), Leadership Education (LE) and Wellness. All students will be given credit towards graduation for successful completion of the AFJROTC program.

Are you worried about your student's schedule? Here is a sample of a 4 years schedule that allows students to take AFJROTC for 4 years and meet all of the high school graduation requirements as well as the requirements for admission to the nation's top universities:

9th Grade

1. English 9
2. Physical Education (PE)
3. Biology
4. AFJROTC (Elective credit; PE possible)
5. Math (Algebra 1 or Geometry)
6. Elective (often language)

10th Grade

1. English 10
2. AFJROTC (PE cred. BOTH terms)
3. Math
4. World History or AP Euro History
5. Chemistry
6. Elective (often language)

11th Grade

1. English or AP English
2. AFJROTC (Elective credit)
3. Math
4. U.S. History or AP U.S. History
5. Elective (often language)
6. Elective (3rd year of science)

12th Grade

1. English or AP English
2. Gov/Econ or AP Gov/AP Econ
3. AFJROTC (Elective credit)
4. Math
5. Elective (Science)
6. Elective

What can I expect in Air Force JROTC?

1. Weekly classroom schedule includes:

- Mondays – Leadership (LE)/ Aerospace Science (AS) Education
- Tuesdays - LE/AS Education
- Wednesdays – Drill & Ceremonies
- Thursdays – LE/AS Education
- Fridays – Wellness/Physical Training
- Monday – Thursday – 2:30-4:00 – Drill Comp Practice (voluntary)
