CAASPP TESTING 3RD - 5TH GRADES

CALIFORNIA ASSESSMENT OF STUDENT PERFORMANCE AND PROGRESS

TESTING WINDOW

Our Third, Fourth, and Fifth-grade students are preparing to take the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) in the next few weeks. Our testing window will begin on Monday, May 2, and will end on Friday, May 20.

May 8th -12th - Students in grades 3 - 5 will participate in the ELA portion of the test.

May 15th - 19th - Students in grades 3 - 5 will participate in the Math portion of the test.

May 22nd - 26th - Only 5th-grade students will participate in the Science portion of the test.

Please avoid making appointments during these testing times as it is extremely important your child is at school, testing in their regular classroom.

**There will be NO FRIDAY FLAG ASSEMBLIES during the testing windows. Friday Flags will resume on Friday, May 26th.

WHAT IS CAASPP?

CAASPP is the California Assessment of Student Progress and California Assessment of **Student Performance and Progress** Performance. Students take the assessment in the Spring and begin receiving score reports in the Summer. CAASPP is an assessment intended to provide information that can be used to monitor student progress along the grade level standards and ensure that all students leave high school ready for college and career.



CAASPP is an assessment that is completed entirely online and includes computer adaptive tests and performance tasks in English-Language Arts, Mathematics and Science. All 3rd and 4th grade students are expected to complete assessments in English-Language Arts and Math. All 5th grade students are expected to complete assessments in English-Language Arts, Math, and Science.

CAASPP scores are not factored into students' overall grades, but the scores do give us valuable feedback about how students are performing academically from year to year. This information is further factored into our Dashboard data which drives the LCAP services that we receive.

WHAT CAN YOU DO AT HOME TO PREPARE FOR THE TEST?

- Make sure that your child gets to bed early each night and gets plenty of rest.
- Have your child eat breakfast each morning before school.
- Please makes sure your child attends each day for the test
 their attendance matters for the test as well!
- Please have your child come to school on time. Once the test has started, students will not be allowed to enter the classroom. Students will have to make the test on a makeup day.
- Avoid removing your child from school during their testing time for appointments. Studies have shown that students perform better when they are able to test in their regular classroom. Make-up tests will be done in an alternate setting.
- Practice for the test please see steps below to access the practice tests.

PRACTICE TESTS

If you would like to do practice tests, there is an online practice portal available for parents and students to access. Students will access this and be able to practice putting in their State ID number. However, parents and students can log in as a guest and access the practice tests.
