Good afternoon!

With tomorrow being the day for our field trip to Naval Air Station North Island, I wanted to provide some final reminders to cadets, parents, guardians, and our five chaperones. PLEASE read the information below carefully to ensure nothing is missed.

**IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ ALL INFO BELOW:**

- **Reporting Time and Location:** 7 am in the AFJROTC room area
- **Uniform:** Combination 7 with the NEW BLUE morale t-shirt
- **Do NOT wear:** Skirts, dresses, tank tops, high heels or open toed shoes (wearing sneakers/tennis shoes is best).
- *\*\*The ship is an industrial environment with lots of trip hazards, narrow ladder wells, etc.\*\**
- **Items to Bring:** Student ID, driver's license/state picture ID (if 18 or older), water bottle and any snack(s) who wish to have. Cadets may bring a small bag (up to the size of a small purse). Backpacks should NOT be brought.

Parents, Guardians:

Good morning!

If you cadet hasn't already mentioned it, we have an awesome field trip in the works for next month. Specifically, we will be heading to Naval Air Station North Island (on Coronado) on 9 March to tour several base organizations, which will likely include a helicopter squadron and the USS Carl Vinson (a nuclear class aircraft carrier!).

This will be an all-day field trip, so students who join us will miss the entire school day. While some details are still being worked out, the basic plan is to depart campus at 7:30 am and return at approximately 4:45 pm. As the number of visitors is

being restricted by the naval base, we can take only 50 cadets. As I anticipate we will have more than 50 interested, we'll likely have to make a cutoff based on academic standing. With that, if you know you do NOT want your student missing the school day--or otherwise participating in the field trip--PLEASE be sure to email me no later than 25 February. This date will be the last day for students to express interest in going.

For those who are able to join us as a chaperone, I am looking for 5 parent/guardian volunteers (all will need to ride on the bus with us, unless a military ID card holder). Barring any changes, we will plan for chaperones and cadets to meet in the AFJROTC area no later than 7:00 am for an in brief. The cadets will then march to the bus at 7:20 to board and leave campus on time. We will depart NAS North Island at 3:00 pm, with the goal of being back at TVHS around 4:45pm.

If you are able to join us as a chaperone, simply email me saying so. I will acknowledge receipt by responding and including an adult field trip waiver to complete. The waiver can either be scanned and emailed back to me, or can be brought in the morning of. I'll take volunteers in the order I receive email responses.

As always, I truly appreciate your support! More details will be emailed as we get a bit close to 9 March.
