- ✓ Complete FAFSA/CADAA Application
- ✓ Complete the required credits in each subject below:

California University Admission Requirements (A-G)

- ✓ UCs: 10th-12th A-G minimum GPA is 3.0.
- ✓ CSUs: 10th-12th A-G GPA minimum GPA is 2.5
- ✓ Graduate from high school
- ✓ Complete the required credits in A-G subject categories below:

MATH	30 CREDITS (MUST INCLUDE ALGEBRA I)	C: MATH	3 YEARS (30 CREDITS) BUT 4 YEARS RECOMMENDED
SCIENCE	20 CREDITS (10 CREDITS PHYSICAL SCI & 10 CREDITS LIFE SCI)	D: LAB SCIENCES	2 YEARS (20 CREDITS) BUT 3 YEARS RECOMMENDED
LOTE (LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH)	NOT REQUIRED (BUT THESE CREDITS CAN SUBSTITUTE FOR VADA REQUIREMENT FOR GRADUATION ONLY)	E: LOTE (LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH)	2 YEARS (20 CREDITS OF SAME LANGUAGE) BUT 3 YEARS RECOMMENDED
VADA (VISUAL & PERFORMING ARTS)	10 CREDITS	F: VADA (VISUAL & PERFORMING ARTS)	1 YEAR (10 CREDITS)
PE (PHYSICAL EDUCATION)	20 CREDITS	G: COLLEGE PREP ELECTIVE	1 Year (10 CREDITS)
ELECTIVES	70 CREDITS	CSUs & UCs No longer require an ACT nor SAT score for admission. However, these scores can help with college placement in English & Math
