#### **Important Reminders**

Please drive safely in the school parking lot and the surrounding streets. Please remember not to turn left when exiting the parking lot during arrival or dismissal.

When dropping off student(s), please pull all the way to the car drop off gate before letting student(s) exit the car. We must work together to keep the cars in the valet zone moving. Please do not park in the valet zone and walk your child(ren) to the gate. If you would like to walk your child(ren) to the front gate, please park in a parking space and utilize the crosswalks to walk to the front gate.

Parent/Guardian drivers are not allowed to drive in the bus loop on Mountain Meadows Dr. at anytime before 3:00pm Mon.-Thurs. and 1:15pm on Fridays/Mini Days.

We greatly appreciate the support of all our Mountain Meadows community to keep our students, staff and families safe in the school parking lot.

Breakfast is served from 7:45-8:15am on Monday-Thursday and 7:45-8:20am on Fridays.

We love our pets, but no pets are allowed on campus unless they are service animals. The campus includes the parking lot and school walkways.
