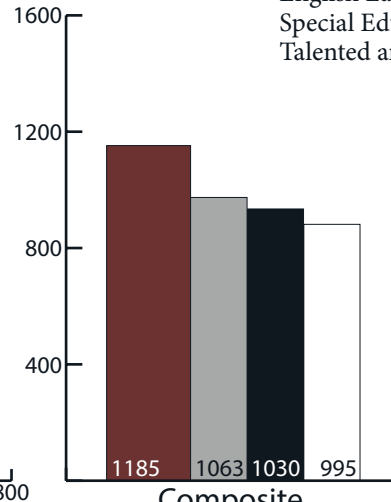
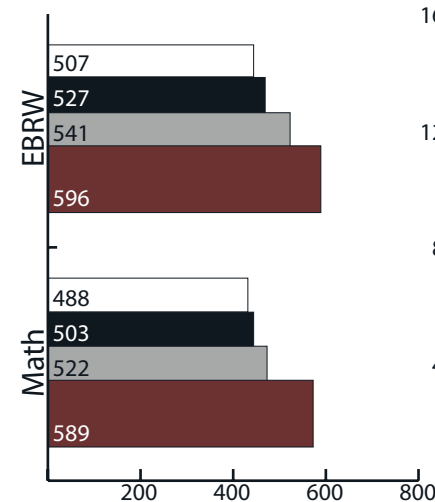


Current Enrollment 2029 Students

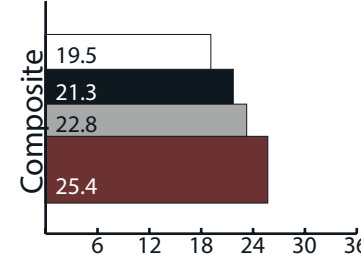

Academics Overview

Alpharetta High School follows a traditional semester schedule. Students typically carry a full schedule of six classes, which may include dual enrollment/college classes, online courses and internship experiences. Cumulative numeric average (CNA) is calculated on a 100 point scale for each student and averages semester grades for each attempted course with the potential to earn high school credit. Seven quality points are awarded to **passing** grades for honors, AP, IB, and dual enrollment/college courses taken **while** the student is enrolled at AHS. Courses taken prior to enrollment at AHS may or may not include honor points, depending on the prior school's policies.
