SIS is an IB World School offering the Primary Years Programme (PYP), Middle Years Programme Candidate (MYP) and the IB Diploma Programme (IBDP), and is fully accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC). We are a member of the East Asian Council of Overseas Schools (EARCOS), the Association for the Advancement of International Education (AAIE), and a founding member of All-China and Mongolia International School (ACAMIS) organization.



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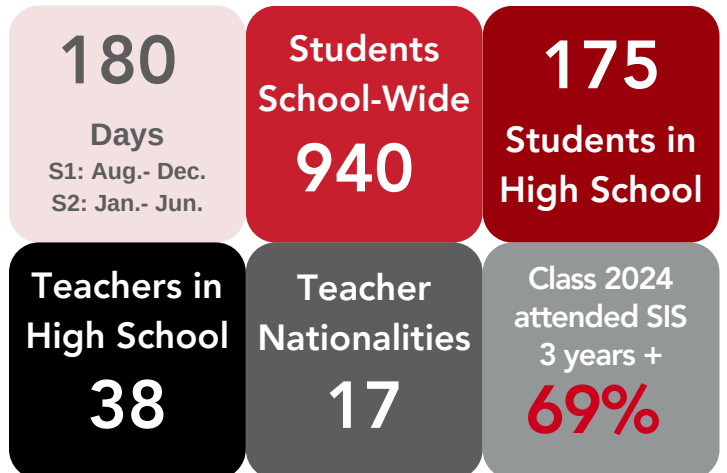
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ACADEMICS

APPLICATION PROCESSES AT SIS

SIS limits students to 10 applications worldwide. Official transcripts and letters of recommendation are sent directly to admissions offices or through CIALFO using Parchment services.

Unofficial transcripts are neither signed nor stamped; these are provided for students to self-report. SIS is a registered SAT centre for SIS students only; we do not prepare students for the SAT, nor do we report SAT data.

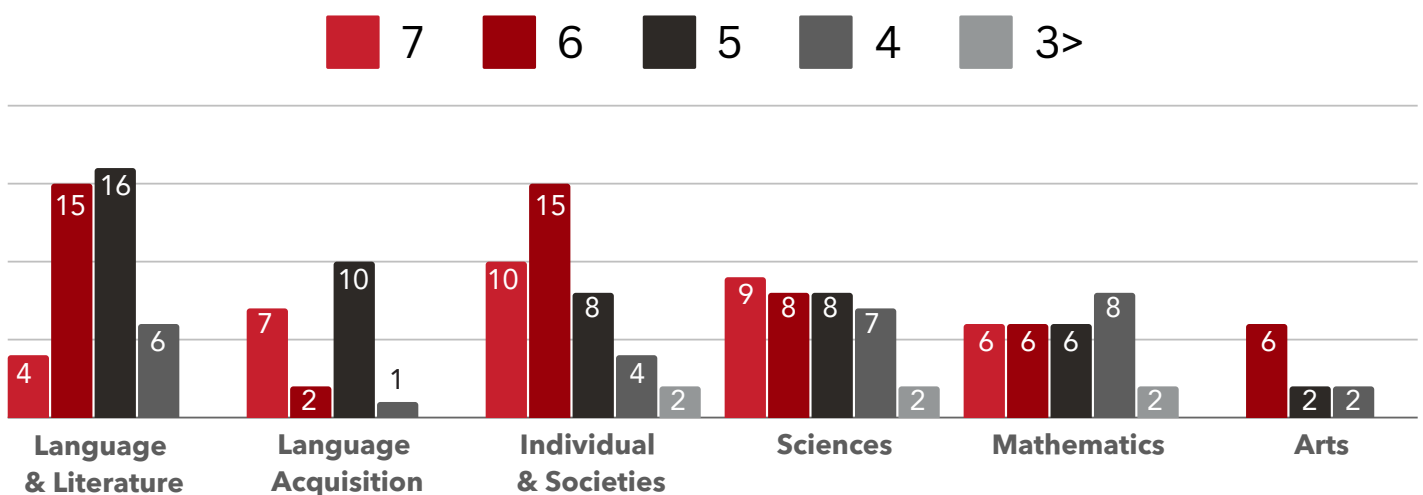
GRADING AND GPA

SIS reports using the 1-7 IB marking scheme. Keeping with the IB philosophy, SIS does not calculate GPA and does not rank students. SIS has maintained the same grading scale and reporting throughout the pandemic.

STATEMENT OF PANDEMIC IMPACT ON CLASS OF 2024

The Class of 2024, our final high school cohort impacted by Covid-19, has shown remarkable achievements. The class average has risen to 36.25, surpassing the world average of 30.32 for the May 2024 session. Seven students scored 40 or above, with one achieving a perfect 45, demonstrating SIS's dedication to innovation in preparing students for the IB Diploma Programme. Additionally, 9 students (36% of the cohort) earned their IB Bilingual Diploma by completing Language and Literature courses in Chinese and English, while 7 students (28% of the cohort) received the maximum 3 points for their Core studies. Congratulations to this cohort of globally-minded graduates!

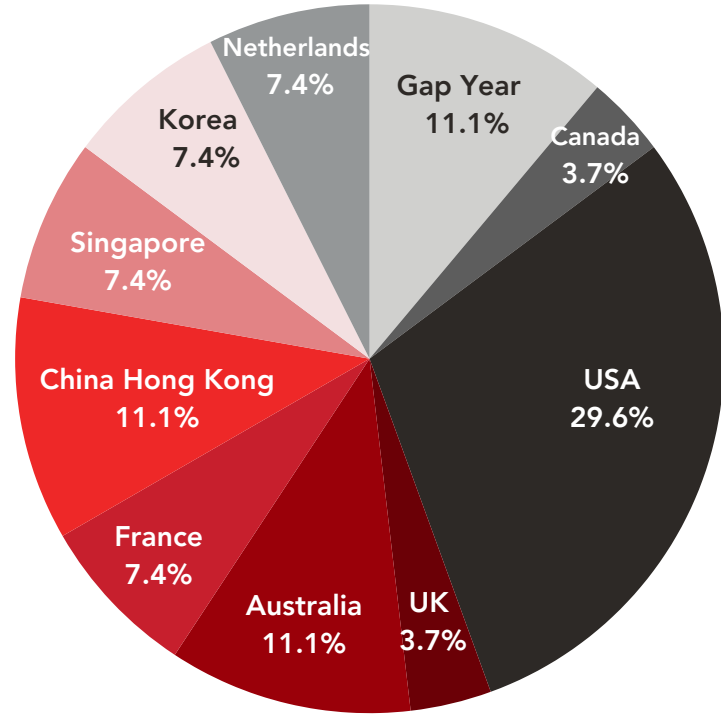
