Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up...

Colder Weather...

It's coming soon!! Please make sure your child has a coat or jacket with them as the weather turns. Thank you for your cooperation let's keep our Bullpups warm and healthy as things get chilly!

Parent -Student Drop Off and Pick-Up...

Please remember to exercise caution as you drive in our parking lot and in the school zone as we have students who walk to school. Parents please obey the designated traffic patterns, especially as the mornings get a darker and the weather gets more challenging. I know mornings are busy for most of us, but collectively we can never be too busy to work together for the safety of our students. We have noticed there are times in the morning and afternoon when parents are waiting in a long drop off line but there are lots of spots open in the main lot- if you wind up in the unfortunate circumstance that you are blocking traffic to the lot while waiting for the drop off line to move...please consider pulling into the main lot and parking and walking your student to the sidewalk.




We have had great success in keeping Maltby a distraction-free learning environment by following these procedures. In addition, we ask that parents please refrain from calling or texting their student during the school day.





Michigan School Meals 2024-25

Brighton Area Schools will participate in the **Michigan School Meals Program** for the 2024-25 school year. **Michigan School Meals** is a state-funded program that provides reimbursement for meals, so all students receive the meals at no cost.

To participate, students just need to show up and take a qualified meal. A school lunch consists of five components: protein, grain, fruit, vegetable and fluid milk. For a lunch to qualify *it must consist of a minimum of three of the five components and one of those must be a fruit or vegetable.* Incomplete meals and individual meal components will be charged at a la carte pricing.

Families are strongly encouraged to complete the **EDUCATION BENEFITS APPLICATION**. Students and families may qualify for other District program fee reductions based on their eligibility. This includes SAT testing, Pay-to-Participate and more.


The number of eligible students helps secure additional funding for the District including Title I funding.




