- Principal's Report
  - Total 1,419 enrollment
  - The school is still hiring for multipurpose instructional assistants, afterschool staff, and a cafe worker. A new secretary was approved and a special ed. aide was recommended. A third guidance counselor and fourth grade teacher were recommended. Other vacancies: music and fourth grade teacher, interviews have been completed.



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- Staff have worked hard in bi-monthly SAM'S club meetings to implement Kagan Structures for teachers to plan and take back to the classroom.
- Approximately 70 students are participating in the after school tutoring program.
- Field trips for Spring have begun: 1st, 3rd, and 4th grade going to Matilda play and 5th grade to Patriots Point
- February 8th- Multicultural Night was a big success
- February 15th- 3rd grade performance- well attended
- Technology club is meeting in preparation for March 27th Tech Fair
- February 27th CCU lacrosse teams read to Kindergarten
