

### **General Information**

#### **Emergency School Closings**

School cancellation is decided only after a thorough check with the Weather Bureau, district transportation services, local police and town highway authorities.

If the cancellation of the school day appears possible during poor weather conditions, parents/guardians should turn to the following television stations to confirm closings:

Also, please check our school website at www.cheektowagasloan.org In the event of school closings all evening and after school programs are also closed.

#### **School District Transportation Services**

The district, in coordination with First Student, Inc. has developed a transportation system to comply with school district regulations. All bus stops are reviewed annually and pick up locations are designated to improve the student transportation system. All prior year bus stops are subject to change.

First Student, Inc. annually notifies all registered students, via U.S. mail of their assigned bus stops during the months of July and August. If you have not received notice by August 25th, please call First Student, Inc. @ 716-821-0647. First Student, Inc. will also be able to handle any questions or concerns about your assigned stops.

Resident students who require transportation to a private or parochial school must submit a transportation request form every year to the School District Office, 166 Halstead Avenue, Sloan, New York, 14212. Forms must be submitted by April 1 preceding the beginning of the next school year. Applications are available from your private/parochial school office, in the spring issue of the district newsletter or by calling the Transportation Department @ 891-6404.

Please help keep our school records current by notifying the school offices with new addresses, home/work telephone numbers or new day care providers. At times, it is extremely important for school personnel to reach parents/guardians in case of emergency.



#### School Facilities Use

The Cheektowaga-Sloan Schools belong to the community and are available to individuals or groups for worthwhile activities when they are not being used for school functions. #### WORKING PAPERS

Applications for working papers for all 14-17 year olds who plan to work part time may be obtained in the John F. Kennedy Guidance office.

To receive a working permit, students must bring:

- The completed application signed by the parent/guardian
- Proof of a physical exam conducted within the last year. This can be obtained from the health office in the high school if the student had a physical for school sports, OR from the family physician.
- The student will then sign and receive the age appropriate working card.

Students requiring a news carrier permit, ages 11-17, are not required to have a physical examination if the student participates in regular physical education classes at school.

#### Don't Know Who To Call?

Occasionally, questions or concerns arise which require immediate attention. Ordinarily you should contact the individual most closely associated with the area of concern. For example, call the teacher when the problem relates to the classroom; call the principal if the item relates to a situation within a particular building or a particular faculty member; call the guidance office if there is a scheduling problem; call the transportation department if the problem occurs in relation to the buses. If you are unable to resolve your problem through normal channels, you may contact the Superintendent of Schools.

#### School Census

The Cheektowaga-Sloan UFSD conducts a school census to assist with the educational planning process and the updating of school district records. The School District Office will mail census forms to all district residents. A savings can be realized if the head of each household will supply the needed information requested on these census forms. Please mail the forms back using the supplied preaddressed envelope. All postage is pre-paid. Or you may go online as per directions supplied in the census letter.

Please look for the SCHOOL CENSUS forms mailed to your home during the months of April & May. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

#### Registration Information:

Any parent or guardian permanently residing in the Cheektowaga-Sloan Union Free School District boundaries may register his or her student(s) in one of our schools. All registrations are handled through our Central Registrar in the District Business Office. The registration process is very simple and includes the completion of the CSUFSD registration packet and provision of copies of the following documentation:

- Registering Child's documentation of birth
- Registering Parent's Photo identification
- Three (3) Proofs of Residency visit "bit.ly/3QHo0qn" for a complete list of acceptable proofs.
- Health Records including physician signed physical and immunizations
- Current report card and signed record release form included in packet
- Guardianship documentation, if applicable: (Family Court documentation such as custody, divorce and or guardianship papers
- Foster care documentation (form DSS-2999)
- Special Education documentation, if applicable (Individual Educational Plan (IEP) or 504 plan)

There are three ways to register:

- 1. Online Registration: please visit the following website: https://parentportal.wnyric.org/sloancsd and click the "Online Registration" button to get started. If you have a child who already attends one of our schools, you should first login to your Parent Portal account and click "Register New Student."
- In Person with a registration appointment with the central registrar at the district office. Please contact Angela Filipski at 716-891-6427.
- 3. Completed Registration Packet: All required forms are available at www. cheektowagasloan.org/registration. Mail, email or hand deliver copies of all completed registration forms and required documentation to prove guardianship and residency. You may email completed application to sloanregistration@csufsd.org, or mail to the following address: Cheektowaga-Sloan Union Free School District Attn: Central Registrar 166 Halstead Ave., Sloan, NY 14212

Once the Registration packet has been completed and all documentation is provided, it takes between 3 to 5 business days to process the application. At that point a school representative will contact you to set up an enrollment date.

### Kindergarten Registration

A student is eligible to enroll in Kindergarten if his or her 5th birthday falls on or before December 1 following the start of the school year in September. If you are interested in enrolling your son or daughter in our Kindergarten program, please follow the registration process described above. New entrants are expected to participate in our Kindergarten Screening Process for school readiness. Screenings and orientation are typically scheduled in May, so it is important to register early. The orientation program includes a meet and greet at Theodore Roosevelt to discuss school procedures, a short bus ride, and a visit to the classrooms ending with a snack, compliments of the Theodore Roosevelt PTO.

## Important Notice of Changes in Cheektowaga-Sloan Union Free School District's Child Nutrition Program

Effective July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025

The Cheektowaga-Sloan Union Free School District is approved by the New York State Department of Education for the Community Eligibility Provision.

What does this mean for all students attending any school within the District?

- All students enrolled in any building within the
  District are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and
  lunch at school at no charge every day of the school
  year. Students will be able to participate in these meal
  programs without having to pay a fee or submit an application.
- Our school is eligible to receive additional state and federal funds based on the number and/or percentage of students enrolled who reside in households that meet established federal income guidelines. We use the Family Income Questionnaire to collect household information. While completion of this application is not required for student to receive a free breakfast or lunch, completion of such application will help the District qualify for education funds and discounts. Thus, we urge each family to complete this application. If you receive an application, please help our school district by completing and submitting the form to Erin Greene, Food Service Director, 305 Cayuga Creek Road, Cheektowaga, NY 14227.
- If a student wants to purchase a second entrée, juice, milk or other ala carte items, they will need to have money on their account, or cash in hand. Additionally, students will also have the opportunity to purchase a variety of snacks and beverages that comply with the "Smart Snacks Sold in Schools" regulations. These items must be purchased and no charging will be allowed. Students have the option of paying for snacks as they come through the line, or on "MySchoolBucks" website.

Should your child need a special diet prescribed by a licensed medical physician, please have detailed instructions sent to us as soon as possible on your physician's letterhead.

We believe that this new "Community Eligibility" designation will allow all students within the District to be the most productive and healthy learners possible.





#### **Board of Education**

The Cheektowaga-Sloan UFSD Board of Education is composed of seven members, elected at-large, by the voters in the Cheektowaga-Sloan community. Each member is elected for a five-year term. To qualify for membership on the school board, an individual must be a qualified voter of the district, a Cheektowaga-Sloan resident for at least one year prior to the election, and a United States citizen.

The Board of Education is a corporate body, which oversees and manages public school district affairs, personnel, and properties. It operates under the guidelines set forth by the Education Laws of the State of New York and the State Board of Regents. It is the official policy-making body of the school district. Decisions are rendered only when members are formally assembled at a properly convened meeting.

### Candidacy/Term

The Cheektowaga-Sloan UFSD Board consists of seven members who serve terms of five years. Members must meet the following qualifications:

- A citizen of the United States;
- Must be at least 18 years old;
- Able to read and write;
- · A legal resident of the District one year prior to the election;
- · Cannot be an employee of the Cheektowaga-Sloan School District;
- The only member of his/her family (that is, cannot be a member of the same household) on the Cheektowaga-Sloan Union Free School District Board;
- May not simultaneously hold another, incompatible public office;
- Must not have been removed from a School District office within one year
  preceding the date of election to the Board.
- Not otherwise prohibited from voting under election law, that is a convicted felon or adjudged mentally incompetent.
