IV. Superintendent Report

A. Updates

Dr. Maria Rianna, the Superintendent of Schools, discussed the steps taken following a threat to the district, which she had notified the community about early one morning before school started. She emphasized that all threats are taken seriously and thoroughly investigated until they are fully resolved. Dr. Rianna also mentioned that representatives would be visiting both the middle and high schools to talk to students about the seriousness of such incidents. She stressed that making threats is not a joke and creates dangerous situations, leading to fear and even injury due to panic.

She encouraged anyone who becomes aware of a threat to report it. Additionally, Dr. Rianna noted that the Board of Education will be considering other security

measures and will be working with Homeland Security and other sources to explore options. Security audits are conducted every few years, and the Board of Education is currently reviewing and updating its information to ensure that future decisions are based on the latest guidance.

1. State Tests & NYSESLAT Data Presentation

Dr. Rianna introduced Dr. Alexa Doeschner, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum/Instruction and Technology, who thoroughly presented via PowerPoint covering all data from recent state tests. Questions from the Board of Education were addressed.

Dr. Maria Rianna introduced Valerie Lasser from FAME which is an organization created by alumni that supports the arts and music program within the Glen Cove School District. Ms. Lasser spoke briefly about their October fall fundraiser and mentioned that this year they will be honoring Mr. Ed Norris, whose name will be added to their Tree of Inspiration, located outside of the high school auditorium, for his role in inspiring students. Flyers were available in the hallway.

2. District Goals

Dr. Maria Rianna presented the Board of Education's District Goals via PowerPoint. Copies of the presentation was made available to all in attendance.

3. Music Department Recognition

Dr. Rianna received information that the New York State Theatre Education Association and their Board of Trustees informed us that they selected a New York State Theatre Education Association Administrator of the Year. Mr. Lawrence Nadel was nominated by a Glen Cove School District teacher (Jared Ross) and won this year's award. Mr. Nadel was presented with a certificate of recognition.

Mr. Lawrence Nadel announced the selection of high school student, Jeffrey Ramirez Hernandez, who will be representing New York State and the New York State School Music Association in their 2024 chorus ensemble where he will perform in December in Rochester. He was presented with a certificate of recognition and was photographed along with Dr. Rianna, Ed Norris and Mr. Nadel.
