

West Plains R-VII School District Board of Education Update May 21, 2024 Regular Session Meeting West Plains Middle School Library

Open Session

- President Cindy Tyree called the meeting to order.
- The West Plains R-VII School District Board of Education led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Consent Agenda

• Before approving previous board meeting minutes, the board approved the monthly financial report, resignations, employment, transfers, program evaluations, CSIP update, and ABA Consultants approval. The board approved 7-0.

Regular Agenda

- The monthly bills were paid and approved. The board approved 7-0.
- The payment of the BURO bill was approved. The board approved 6-0-1.

Previous Business

- FY 2024 2025 Budget Update
 - Dr. Davis reviewed several items concerning the upcoming budget. He reminded the board it must be approved during the June board meeting. The following things he addressed concerning it:
 - The budget will be a deficit budget as the large construction projects will be taking place. He also said some of the projects will be paid or partially paid during the 2023-24 school year.
 - Budgeting \$38,000 Teacher Baseline Grant

- But prepped the board, it could be \$40,000 based on legislative action
- \$1,000 local grant for staff above \$38,000
 - (Or above \$40,000 if the teacher baseline salary grant moves forward)
- \$502 paid monthly for full time employee health insurance
- Tiered Stipend Schedule
- Security Hallway at WPHS/East Wing
- Softball/Baseball Turf project
- New fuel tanks at transportation
- Fuel tank removal and DNR fees at transportation
- Two additional school buses
- WPES Dishwasher
- SFES Canopy
- Roofing projects at Transportation

New Business

- Designation of AI Coordinator (CSIP S3 AP2) Tiffany Young was approved as the AI Coordinator for the district. The board approved 7-0.
- 2024A MSBA Policy Update First Read (CSIP S3 AP2) -MSBA has created a new procedure to assist districts with developing standards and rules for acceptable artificial intelligence (AI) use. No action was taken by the board.
- 2024-2025 Salary Schedules (CSIP S AP1 & AP2): Dr. Davis discussed possible changes to the salary schedules, which will be approved in June. The board took no action.
- School Bus Inspection Update (CSIP S1 AP1)—In February, The Missouri State Highway Patrol conducted an annual inspection of the district's school buses. The district has 25 buses in its fleet, each with a 100% pass rate. No action was taken by the board.
- Approval of Surplus Property Bids (CSIP S7 AP1) The board approved the surplus bus bids. The board approved 6-0-1.
- Approval of Fuel Storage Bid (CSIP S7 AP1) The tanks are currently being removed because of a possible leak. The district is working with the Department of Natural Resources to remove them, and then the district will

- install above-ground tanks. The board approved a bid from Mid-South Steel Products of \$108,421. This does not include the concrete and electrical costs associated with the installation. The board approved 7-0.
- Approval of Surplus Property (CSIP S1 AP1) Two fuel dispensers and a suction pump were approved as surplus property by Mr. Orchard. The board approved 7-0.
- Salary and Welfare Committee Presentation (CSIP S7 AP3) Sylvia Hershenon gave a report to the board. No action was taken by the board.

Updates/Reports to the Board of Education

Administrators reported on current events, projects, and plans in their respective buildings or departments.

- Building-Level Reports—SFES, SMTI, WPES, WPMS, WPHS, & ZPA (CSIP S5 AP1)—Dr. Huddleston, Dr. Cotter, Mrs. Hutchinson, Dr. Miller, Mr. Smith, and Mr. Somoza provided reports.
- Public Relations & Communications Report (CSIP S5 AP1, AP2, & AP3) -Lana Snodgras
- Teaching & Learning Report (CSIP S6: AP1 & AP5) Dr. Tiffany Young
- Facility, Human Resources, Security, and Capital Projects Report (CSIP S1 AP1) Matthew Orchard.
- Superintendent's Report (CSIP S1 AP 1; S3 AP1 & AP2; S5 AP 2 & AP3)
 - Dr. Davis discussed revenues and expenditures for the current school year. One remaining large payment from DESE will arrive, and several payrolls, including June, some July, summer school, and Sick Leave will be dispersed in the upcoming month.
 - He shared with the board the upcoming allowable transfers. This moves funds from the operational account to the capital projects account. It totals approximately \$1,000,000 to assist with facility repairs and transportation costs. He commented that he might not transfer the full amount this year but will make that determination next month.
 - He stated he had budgeted \$3,950,000 for tuition collections for the school year; but the actual amount would be \$3,879,653.

- The district has moved the majority of its funds into the new depository account at West Plains Bank. This change was approved in a prior meeting.
- Dr. Davis referenced Senate Bill 727 and stated it has both positives and negatives for the district in his opinion. He stated that it will take time for DESE to enact several of the changes. Currently schools are planning on how this will impact things in the upcoming school years.
 - Becomes effective 8/28/24 (some changes come next year)
 - Districts can claim 8% instead of 4% of preschool count for attendance. He stated this would benefit the district.
 - Small schools grant \$15 \$30 Million has no impact on West Plains
 - Extended charter schools into Boone County (Columbia area)
 - FY 2026
 - o Minimum \$40,000 base
 - Minimum \$46,000 MS with 10 years
 - Dr. Davis strongly supports this but is fearful because there is no funding designed to help with this initiative.
 - Calendar Incentive
 - Districts can gain some financial incentive to have a total of 169 days of instruction. He did not recommend changing next year's calendar for this.
 - DESE Student Aid Calculation Attendance and enrollment will be used to calculate student funding from DESE. In the past, it was just attendance. Dr. Davis stated this should be a positive move for the district.
