

West Plains R-VII School District Board of Education Update April 16, 2024 Regular Session Meeting West Plains High School Library

Open Session & Student/Staff Spotlight

- President Jim Thompson called the meeting to order.
- The West Plains R-VII School District Board of Education led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- During the student spotlight, Mr. Smith featured the Future Teachers of America (FTA) students and faculty. Mrs. Campbell and Mrs. Pitts discussed the program. Two students also participated in the discussion with the school board concerning what the program is all about.



Consent Agenda

• Before approving previous board meeting minutes, the board approved the monthly financial report, resignations, employment, transfers, and program evaluations. (The board approved 7-0)

Regular Agenda

• The monthly bills were paid and approved. (The board approved 7-0)

Previous Business

- CSIP Update (CSIP 4.5) Strategy 4 Early Childhood Education
 - The information was provided in the packet for the board to review.
- Approve Depository Bid (CSIP S7 AP1) -
 - The district is required to bid out its banking services every five years.
 The bids have been received, and the district has chosen West Plains
 Bank & Trust Company, which will be effective July 1, 2024. (The board approved 7-0)
- Tiered Stipend Schedule (CSIP S7 AP1)
 - Dr. Davis worked with coaches, staff, and sponsors to create stipend tiers. He collected years of experience information from all the current and newly hired staff receiving stipends. (The board approved the stipend tiers 7-0.) The stipend tiers will soon be available on the district website under "Human Resources."
- Approval of Amended 2024-2025 School Calendar (CSIP S5 AP1) -
 - An adjustment has been made to the 2024 2025 academic calendar to correct a day that was unaccounted for in March. The spring semester for 24-25 will conclude one day earlier than initially scheduled. All other dates on the calendar remain unchanged. You can find the updated calendar soon on the district website under the "For Parents" section.
- Approval of 2024 2025 Health Insurance Plan (CSIP S7 AP1) -
 - Or. Davis asked for this to be tabled as he has received some updated info. No action was taken by the board. He did inform the board that a decision must be made by May 1 and the board would likely have a special meeting to approve any changes.

- Salary and Welfare Committee Presentation (CSIP AP 1 & AP 3)
 - Sylvia Hershenson thanked the school board for all the salary and benefits that have happened over the previous two years. Some of the items she noted were:
 - Teachers receiving credit for years worked
 - Tiered Stipend Schedule
 - Bereavement Leave
 - Mental Health Care
 - The \$1.00 raise provided to all hourly employees this year
 - Approving the movement early for the 2024-25 school year
 - She discussed the committee's continual work with Dr. Davis and Mr.
 Orchard on health insurance. And gave appreciation to them for continuing to work on this for the staff.

Updates/Reports to the Board of Education

Administrators reported on current events, projects, and plans in their respective buildings or departments.

- Building-Level Reports—SFES, SMTI, WPES, WPMS & ZPA (CSIP S5 AP1)—Dr. Huddleston, Dr. Cotter, Mrs. Hutchinson, Dr. Miller, Mr. Smith, and Mr. Somoza all provided reports.
- Public Relations & Communications Report (CSIP S5 AP1, AP2, & AP3) -Lana Snodgras
- Teaching & Learning Report (CSIP S6: AP1 & AP5) Tiffany Young
- Facility, Human Resources, Security, and Capital Projects Report (CSIP S1 AP1) Matthew Orchard.
- Superintendent's Report (CSIP S1 AP 1; S3 AP1 & AP2; S5 AP 2 & AP3)
 - Dr. Davis commented on the school closure during the eclipse. And was thankful the board supported the closure. He discussed the issue the buses could have had with the influx of traffic.
 - O District revenue collections are at \$27,531,560 for the year with \$2,388,576 of that coming from tuition collections.

- O Total district expenses are at \$25,334,951 for the year. He mentioned that there are several payrolls still left to be paid in this fiscal year. He noted that the state required amount of funds for Professional Development has been expended. His concern was that the district has already surpassed the budgeted amount for sub teachers this year. He referenced that the district had already budgeted more than the previous year but this year has had a very high number of sub requests.
- Discussion was held concerning the 2024-25 budget. This will be reviewed more in the May board meeting and then approved in June.
 Some of the specific items Dr. Davis discussed are as follows:
 - Continuation of the state minimum salary grant
 - Horizontal and vertical movement on the salary schedules already approved
 - Catching teachers up on years of service already board approved
 - Tiered Stipend Schedule already board approved
 - East Wing/WPHS Connection hallway already board approved
 - Softball field/Baseball field turf already board approved
 - Funds for carpentry class to build a press box
 - GOCSD Professional Development funding
 - Literacy and Library/Classroom books
 - Two school buses already board approved
 - School cars
 - Fuel tanks replacement at the transportation facilities Currently the tanks are in the process of being removed because of a possible leak. The district is working with the Department of Natural Resources to remove these and then the district will install above ground tanks in the future. Dr. Davis informed the board that this total cost will be several hundred thousand dollars and could take a few years to navigate.
- Dr. Davis discussed several current legislative bills at the state level. He
 talked about the impact or potential impact these bills could have on
 the district.
