The school year is well under way, and we are excited about what's happening in P.E. Even though it is "fall", it is still very hot outside, so keep that in mind on P.E. weeks. Students will be most comfortable in shorts and short-sleeved shirts. If your child wears dresses/skirts during P.E. weeks, please make sure that shorts are worn underneath. Please remember, students are expected to wear sneakers to P.E. Boots, sandals, Crocs, etc. are not safe. Thank you for your support with this. :)



In October, we will begin fitness testing and will continue the Sweetwater mile runs for 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students. Students will run the timed mile 3 times. (October, November and December/January) 4th and 5th grade students have the opportunity to earn a "Mile Medal". We take the students' fastest times out of all of their timed miles. Medal Criteria is as follows: Gold (Under 8:00), Silver (8:00 - 9:30), Bronze (9:31 - 11:00) We work on building endurance EVERYDAY in PE. We discuss pacing, running strategies and talk about the importance cardio-vascular health.

Data shows that children who do not learn fundamental gross motor skills such as skipping, throwing, kicking, galloping, etc. by the age of 9, tend to never reach fluency with those skills. Our K-2 physical education program is movement based with a focus on locomotor movement patterns and gross motor skills. Repetition of such movements are embedded into tag games, relays, and a variety of other activities. We also focus on skill based games to learn/practice skills included in our PE standards. (catching, throwing, rolling, striking with implements, chasing & fleeing, etc.) The goal of the program is to not only develop a variety of physical skills, but to also develop an appreciation of physical activity for health, enjoyment, and social interaction. (Including a strong emphasis on sportsmanship!)
