Subject: Dual College Credit

Sabin-Schellenberg Professional Technical Center and regional community colleges have partnered to allow students to earn both high school and college credits. If these credits were taken at the community colleges, tuition fees would apply. By taking classes through the Advanced College Credit (ACC) program at Sabin-Schellenberg Center, the same college credits will cost much less or absolutely nothing.

Even if your student has no plans to attend college, they can benefit from Advanced College Credit. The credits earned in this program will be transcribed by the community college and are transferable to many Oregon colleges and universities, as well as to out-of-state institutions. It is always best to check with the specific institution your student plans to attend. The credit goes with the student wherever and whenever they go to college. The credits may also help a student advance more quickly in the military or in the workforce.

The on-line registration process for the Advanced College Credit will begin in February, March & April for students in second semester articulated courses. Students should be encouraged to register for the college credit only if they are earning good grades, as this will help them succeed in the future. Grades and the time frame in which a student earns credits might impact future eligibility for Federal Financial Aid. The ACC registration for most SSC courses that offer college credit opens Spring Term. A list of articulated courses can be found below. You may check the community college website for dates and course information. Students are responsible to monitor their progress, register within the ACC registration timelines and drop the college course by the drop deadline when grades are not what they would want on their college transcript.
