Dear Parent or Guardian,

Subject: Clackamas Community College Advanced College Credit

Sabin-Schellenberg Professional Technical Center and Clackamas Community College (CCC) have partnered to allow students to earn both high school and college credits for approved Advanced College Credit (ACC) classes. If these credits were taken at CCC they would cost \$117 per credit (in-state tuition only), but with ACC, the cost is just \$10 per college credit. By taking classes through the Advanced College Credit program at Sabin-Schellenberg Center, the same college credits cost substantially less.

Your student is enrolled in one or more of these courses at Sabin-Schellenberg Center. Your student can benefit from Advanced College Credit, even if their current plan doesn't include college. For students who register, the credits earned in this program will be transcribed by CCC and are transferable to many Oregon colleges and universities, as well as to out-of-state institutions. It is always best to check with the specific institution your student plans to attend. The credit goes with the student wherever and whenever they go to college. The credits may also help a student advance more quickly in the military or in the workforce. Each student should consider the advantages of college credit and if it will fit into their own college and career plans.

Advanced College Credit registration in the current semester is now open to eligible students. Your student's teacher can be of assistance during their Sabin-Schellenberg course to go on-line, create a CCC myClackamas account and register for the ACC credit. Or students may follow the enclosed directions to register using any computer access. Once the registration period has closed for the course, the opportunity to sign up for that college credit is no longer available. Students with outstanding balances from past ACC courses will not have access to further ACC course registration. Outstanding balances can be accessed through the student's CCC myClackamas account and resolved with payment.

Please note the November 8, 2024 deadline.

After registering on-line, students are encouraged to print an invoice showing the cost of tuition for the course, and bring the invoice to their parent/guardian for payment. Parents/guardians may pay on-line with a credit card, or mail the invoice with a check directly to Clackamas Community College.
