Learning Labs

BISTRO



Students will manage all aspects of the bistro and learn about customer service, food preparation/service, communication, and teamwork.

APARTMENT



The apartments provide a hands on learning experience for students to experience cooking, cleaning, laundry, and other functions needed in a living space.

BOUTIQUE



The boutique is a storefront that features products made by the students in the production lab as well as coffee provided by Katz Coffee through our partnership at no cost.

PRODUCTION



In the production lab, students will learn about product development and utilize these skills by creating products, such as jewelry, that will be sold in the boutique.

PRINT SHOP



The print shop gives students an opportunity to learn job skills related to printing, packaging, laminating, and assembly.

LOGISTICS



The Logistics Lab will focus on the skills needed for working in a warehouse setting or production lab that includes stocking, inventorying, filling orders, and delivery.

CUSTODIAL



The custodial lab is a collaboration with our custodial department where students will learn necessary skills required to safely and effectively use cleaning materials and equipment.

ACADEMIC



The academic lab is set up like a traditional classroom for students to work on functional academics and prepare students who may have post-secondary school opportunities.

INTERVIEW PREP



The interview preparation lab,, which includes a 2 way-mirror for interview feedback, provides an opportunity to learn about and practice interview skills that include social, communication, and job readiness skills.

Safety & Security

Keeping our students safe is a top priority. The Bridge Center is a fully secure facility, including:

- Six-foot perimeter fencing around the entire center
- New 360° cameras with 22 views, ensuring full coverage of the facility
- Video intercom system at the front gate providing secure entry
- Two-way radios for efficient & prompt communication among staff members & Klein PD
