B. <u>COVID-19 ARPA Capital Projects Fund Multi-Purpose Community Facilities</u> <u>Program - Grant Application</u>

- Dr. Lutz-Doemling and Ms. Wallace discussed the District's plans to apply for the COVID-19 ARPA Capital Projects Fund Multi-Purpose Community Facilities Grant.
- The District will request 2 million dollars to fund the majority of the costs associated with building an addition of approximately 5000 square feet of space to Sheckler Elementary School.
- The additional community space will facilitate digital inclusion activities designed to address community needs while providing additional classroom/office spaces to address Sheckler Elementary School's educational/classroom space challenges. The proposed expansion will not only enhance the learning environment for our students but also serve as a vital resource for the broader community. By providing additional space for community activities and events, we aim to foster a sense of belonging within a safe and supportive educational environment.
- The timeline for the grant application, award, and construction process was shared.
