Chadwick International (CI) opened in 2010 as the sister campus of Chadwick School in Palos Verdes, CA, established in 1935. CI's Class of 2016 was the first cohort to graduate. CI is an authorized IB World School offering the Primary Years Programme (PYP), the Middle Years Programme (MYP), the Diploma Programme (DP), and the Career-Related Programme (IBCP). Chadwick International is regionally accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).

Chadwick International COVID Statement

From February 2020 through SY 2021-2022, CI students had limited access to school-based co-curricular activities; many student-led activities had to be canceled or postponed. Despite this, students were able to develop independent and individual ways to continue their involvement in sports, service, and the creative arts.

◆ CURRICULUM

Academic Policy

Grade 11 and 12 students choose to take the full IB Diploma Programme, some IB Courses, or the IBCP. CI requires that students in the full IBDP take no more than three HL classes. Students are NOT ranked at Chadwick International and we do not calculate or provide GPA's. Students receive one final report (June) and one mid-year progress report (January). Students who transfer into CI mid-year will earn a Pass for courses on their final report. Students are required to study MYP subjects in grades 9 & 10 and complete a Personal Project (Grade 10).

Diploma Requirements

All CI graduates receive an American High School Diploma. A minimum of 22 year-long credits are required for graduation (20 for students with approved accommodations).

- * The MYP Math curriculum integrates Algebra I & II, Geometry, and Trigonometry. The Standard Math Pathway is based on the Standard Common Core curriculum. The Extended Pathway is based on the Accelerated Common Core curriculum.
- ** The MYP Science curriculum integrates Biology, Chemistry, and Physics; this integrated curriculum is deepened and enriched over the years. The sequence is required and each year's course is a laboratory science course.
