WHAT IS FERST?

Ferst Readers' mission is "strengthening communities by providing quality books and literacy resources for children and their families to use at home during the earliest stages of development."

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- A community action team coordinates the securing of funds and the promotion of the program to families
- Families register children ages birth to five years old
- Every month, an age-appropriate book will arrive in the mail, along with a guide to help parents read, talk, and play with their child to encourage development
- \$42 will provide books to one child for an entire calendar year.
