Dear Parent/Guardian:

We are pleased to inform you that your child will be able to earn college credits from Bergen Community College upon successful completion of one of the courses listed on page 2 of this letter. These credits *can* be transferable to other colleges and universities. We encourage you to use **NJ TRANSFER** (<http://www.njtransfer.org/>) to see what community college courses can be transferred to four-year schools in New Jersey.

In order to be awarded college credit, the student must receive a grade of 70% or higher for the overall course grade. Grades for the inter-institutional course will be reflected on Bergen Community's 2025 spring semester transcript.

Program dates: November 18, 2024 – February 28, 2025

Tuition Per Credit: \$78.72 + (\$16.30 one time registration fee)

\$236.16 + \$16.30 = \$252.46 (one 3 credit course)

\$314.88 + \$16.30 = \$331.18 (one 4 credit course)

\$472.32 + \$16.30 = \$488.62 (two 3 credit courses)

Federal Free & Reduced Lunch Program: Tuition Waiver; only **\$16.30**

Transcript Request: www.getmytranscript.com (after grades are posted in July)

In order to enroll in this program, students must register online between November 18, 2024 and February 28, 2025. **Starting November 18, 2024** the Application and Instructions can be found at <https://bergen.edu/academics/k12partnerships/dual-enrollment/>.

A tuition fee of \$78.72 per credit must be paid to Bergen Community College. In addition, a \$16.30 registration fee is added. The \$16.30 registration fee is a one-time annual fee regardless of the number of registered courses. Students who are on the Federal Free & Reduced Lunch Plan do not pay tuition – only the \$16.30 registration fee. There will be a short presentation on Bergen Community's dual enrollment program on October 29, 2024 at 6:00 PM in the media center. This presentation will occur before our college admissions presentation at 6:30.

*AP European History students can earn up to 6 credits. For example, students can earn 6 college credits by registering for both HIS-106 & HIS-107.

Please Note:

In order for your college to see the credits you took through Bergen Community College, you must request a transcript from Bergen Community. As grades from High Schools may be reported to the College by the end of the school year, the best time to request transcripts is after grades are posted on the student's College academics records. We recommend students wait till early July to request transcripts from Bergen Community College.
