

SIXTH FORM SCHOLARSHIPS 2025-2027

SIXTH FORM SCHOLARSHIPS

The Governing Body will offer a number of scholarships for entry to the Sixth Form in September 2025. They are available under three categories for students who have applied for entry to the Sixth Form.

The categories and awards are:

- < Salesian Ethos Scholarships
- < Outstanding Ability Scholarships
- < Academic Excellence Scholarships

The Salesian Ethos and Outstanding Ability scholarships should be applied for by application form with a closing date of Friday 15 November 2024.

Each individual scholarship awarded qualifies for a reduction in fees of £1,500 annually for each of the two years of sixth form study subject to satisfactory performance and review at the end of Year 12, as determined by the College.

It is recommended that even if a current Year 11 student considers that he may be a strong candidate for an Academic Excellence Scholarship that he should nevertheless apply, if he wishes to do so, for a Salesian Ethos or Outstanding Ability Scholarship or both.

Only one scholarship will be awarded to each individual student.

Students who are awarded a scholarship will receive a Scholarship Certificate in recognition of their achievements. These Scholarship Certificates will be presented at Prize Night in November 2025. The financial worth of the scholarship will be deducted from College fees and is separate from any bursary awarded on grounds of need to a student in the Sixth Form.


An Awards Committee will award the Salesian Ethos and Outstanding Ability Scholarships. The constitution of this Committee will comprise:

- Up to four Governors, including the Headmaster.
- Up to four members of staff.

The decision of the Awards Committee will be binding. Neither the College nor its staff or governors will enter into correspondence relating to these decisions. There will be no appeals process.

Salesian Ethos Scholarships

Scholarships will be awarded to the students in Year 11 in Salesian College who, by their conduct and actions during their time at the College, have demonstrated (in the eyes of the Committee) the greatest commitment to the Salesian ethos.



All applications will be considered by the Awards Committee and applicants will be informed in writing by the feast of St John Bosco, Friday 31 January 2025.

Outstanding Ability Scholarships

Scholarships will be awarded to any student in Year 11 both from the College or currently at other schools, who by their participation during their secondary education so far, have demonstrated (in the eyes of the Committee) outstanding ability in any one or more non-academic areas of school life. This may include sport, music, drama or any other field where outstanding achievements has been gained eg in a regional or national competition.

Students wishing to be considered must return the Scholarship Application form with supporting statements by Friday 15 November 2024.

All applications will be considered by the Awards Committee and successful applicants will be informed in writing by the feast of St John Bosco, Friday 31 January 2025.

Academic Excellence Scholarships

Scholarships may be awarded to any student who enters Year 12 of the Salesian College Sixth Form in September 2025 and who have achieved the best academic results in their GCSE examinations in 2025. For this purpose, the scholarships awarded for Academic Excellence will be determined by the quality of the results.

Should more than four students be eligible to be awarded a scholarship in this category, then their award will be determined by the quality of their academic achievement rather than the quantity of examinations passed.

The Headmaster will notify the successful candidates by letter and will make a formal announcement of these awards at the Annual Distribution of Prizes in November 2024.

External Students

We are pleased to accept Scholarship applications from our External Candidates for Outstanding Ability (deadline Friday 15 November 2024) and Academic Excellence (in line with internal students following the publication of GCSE results in August 2025). Further details are available from the Headmaster's Office.

Acceptance of Scholarships

The parents or guardians will be asked to confirm in writing the acceptance of any award within one week of the written notice being received. If any award is not taken up by the parents or guardians for whatsoever reason within the time-scale noted, then the Headmaster will, if he has been so instructed by the Awards Committee, offer the award to such other student or students as have been selected by the Awards Committee.

The award of any scholarship is to be kept under review throughout the award holder's time in the Sixth Form. Whilst the Governors would consider it unusual for an award to be removed, the Awards Committee may, in its sole judgement, determine that a scholarship award shall cease before completion of its term in the event of the award holder failing to meet the College's expected standards of good behaviour and performance.

Sixth Form Keeping Families Together Awards

These awards are distinct from the scholarships offered and can be awarded in conjunction with any scholarship received. Any student, boy or girl, who enters the Salesian College Sixth Form and has a younger sibling studying at the College, is entitled to a *Keeping Families Together* award. The financial worth of this award is a 25% discount off the full fees for each year of sixth form study. No application for a *Keeping Families Together* award is required, except for confirmation of entitlement.
