



Scholarship Support

The Sisters of St. Joseph's call, to serve the dear neighbor without distinction, is one we teach the girls every day — It's a call we must answer as a school community as well. Keeping St. Joe accessible for deserving students of all backgrounds who would not otherwise attend due to affordability — is vitally important.

Facts:

- Scholarship support and tuition assistance is awarded to **36 percent** of our students on average.
- More than **\$1,710,000 will be distributed in the 2024-2025 school year** for scholarship and assistance.
- More significant funding for **scholarships is needed** to keep up with rising costs and the needs of families.
- SJA tuition is currently \$19,990, not including fees and extra-curricular activities.
- The SJA Finance Committee recently approved the following framework for our donors to provide meaningful support for students in need:
 - + **Endowed Scholarship Funds** can help students for years to come through holding the principal, while spending the interest, **starting at a \$50,000 gift level.**
 - + **Partially (1/2 Tuition) Funded Named Endowed Scholarships begin at \$187,500.**
 - + **Fully Funded Named Endowed Scholarships begin at \$375,000.**
 - + Contributions less than \$50,000 may be named, but will be spent down. Awards are granted at 6 percent of each scholarship fund created.
 - + Contributions below \$25,000 will be set up as a student tuition assistance/scholarship fund. Awards will be made until the fund is depleted or additional donations are received.
 - + St. Joseph's Academy works with each donor to ensure their intention is met in concert with the mission of the school.
 - + A variety of payment options are available, including cash, currency, checks, pledge payments, or gifts of stock.
