Rules for applications:

- 1. Applications are due on Monday, October 14th @ 3:00 p.m. to Ms. Rizzo in the Upper School Office, located in Stuart Hall. Your application must be printed and turned in with this page signed by a parent.
- 2. All applications should be typed in English.
- 3. Applicants should write an essay answering each of the guestions below.
- 4. Include your name and grade at the top of each page.
- 5. Students between the grades 9 through 11 are eligible to apply for any trip. Seniors are only eligible to apply for spring break trips.
- 6. Students are eligible to win the award only once during their time at Trinity Prep.
- 7. If the award goes unused by the student for the 2024-25 school year, the award must be returned to the Trinity Parents Organization Auction Fund.
- 8. If you do not have a valid passport, your parent/guardian should provide a letter agreeing to obtain the passport before the trip.
- 9. To claim the award, you or the teacher leading your trip must contact the Business Office to have your scholarship applied towards your trip fees.
- 10. Winners of the award will be asked to give a short presentation about their trip at the following year's Ellis Award assembly, usually held in the first semester.
- 11. Dishonesty in any form will result in disqualification and potential disciplinary
