Uniforms

Cell Phones

Students are not permitted to use cell phones during the school day. Parents, please call or email the school if you need to reach your warriors.

Parking Reminders

During Drop Off: Please be mindful of double parking in the street as our school is located on a residential street and to be respectful of our neighbors, I am asking that you do find parking where available OR drop off and keep moving forward.

During Dismissal: Please do not park on Callowhill near the corner of Felton closest to Boys' Latin. We are excited to have 3 School Buses this year and that is their designated area to park.

****NOTE** Our School Parking Lot will be CLOSED & INACCESSIBLE from Monday, September 30th - Friday, October 4th** due to continued construction on our gym! Please do not park in front of the entrance to our Parking Lot during drop off or dismissal and plan to park on Felton, the next block down on Callowhill or 63rd Street next week.
