8 & Under – 50m, 100m

9-10 Years – 50m, 100m, 200m

11-12 Years – 50m, 100m, 200m

13-14 Years – 50m, 100m, 200m

15 & Over – 50m, 100m, 200m

Entry Fee: 100 RMB

Scratches:

From 3:00 PM Wednesday, October 16 only scratches will be accepted.

Meet Protocols:

The first false start will be charged to the field. A second false start will result in athlete(s) disqualification. Flyover starts for all individual events. (Except for Backstroke; and the pool will be cleared for all Relays) FINA Rules apply.

Entry Limitations:

- Each individual may enter a maximum of three (3) individual events and two (2) relays.
- Each school may enter a maximum of four (4) swimmers per event.
- Swimmers are permitted to “swim up” to an older age group event, but this must be consistent for all events (individual) during that meet.
- Swimmers may swim up for the relays (NO repeats). They must swim up for all relays at the meet.
- Each school may enter two (2) relay teams per event. Only one (1) relay team (A) can score.
- Each swimmer must have time. **No NT** in entries.
- All heats are timed finals.
- **ONLY HY-TEK TEAM MANAGER FILES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**



Scoring:

The scoring point system for individual events will recognize the first six (6) swimmers. Any combined events are scored according to the age group & gender. Points will be awarded as follows.

Recognition:

Trophy Cup – Overall Champion (Cumulative points from Hy-Tek System)

Trophy – 1st, 2nd, 3rd place Top Age Group (Boys and Girls)

Medal – 1st, 2nd, 3rd place Individual Event medal by Event/Age Group

Ribbon – 4th, 5th, 6th Place

Ribbon - Heat winner

Uniforms:

Swimmers from each school will compete in swimsuits and team swim caps (where caps are chosen to be worn).

Officials:

Each school will provide one volunteer official for this event.

Warm-Ups:

All warm-ups need to take place according to the set schedule and lane assignments. All swimmers need to be out of the pool by 8:40 a.m. Marshaling for the first event will start promptly at 8:45 a.m. - immediately after the warm-ups. The meet will start at **9:00 a.m.**

Campus Access:

All student-athletes, coaches, and visitors use the Main Gate to access HIS Campus. Visitors must sign in at the Main Gate and always wear the visitor's badge inside the campus.

Safety/Boundary Area:

During the meet, participants will be expected to stay within the closed campus of HIS in the allocated areas of the outside staging area and Pool. Ball games and throwing games in the staging/resting area are not allowed.

**Parking:**

Parking will be available on the roads (map will be provided). The traffic police will allow to park on those roads provided you don't block the bike lanes and you don't park in a double line.

If you plan to come by bus, the bus can park inside the campus. You will need to provide us with the school's name and plate number of the bus via email/WeChat Group in advance. Bus access through East Gate.

Team Staging Area:

A designated area will be set up as a "team staging area," and divisions will be set aside for each team. Please leave all belongings in these designated areas, not the pool deck.

Dress Code:

All teams are asked to respect the school dress code when they leave the pool area.

Food and Water:

All teams should bring their reusable water bottles. Plenty of water will be available through water coolers. The Café is open during the event. More details regarding food options will be made available in the week leading up to the event.

Hospitality Room:

The Wave front office will be our customary hospitality room for our coaches.

First Aid:

Each school should bring its first aid kit for minor injuries. There will be a nurse/trainer at the meet for the duration of the event.

Adult Toilets:

Adult toilets are clearly labeled for child protection: Adults / Students. The Main building is labeled clearly with exit routes and how to proceed in case of fire and evacuation.

Pool Shoes/Flip flops:

Please remind your swimmers to wear flip flops/pool shoes.

End of the event:

All schools are required to stay for the duration of the event and may leave after the announcement of results, and their team area has been cleaned.

Finally, I appreciate you taking the time to work with us in hosting this event. We look forward to your team's participation in this meet. I trust there will be some terrific competition. Good luck to all!
