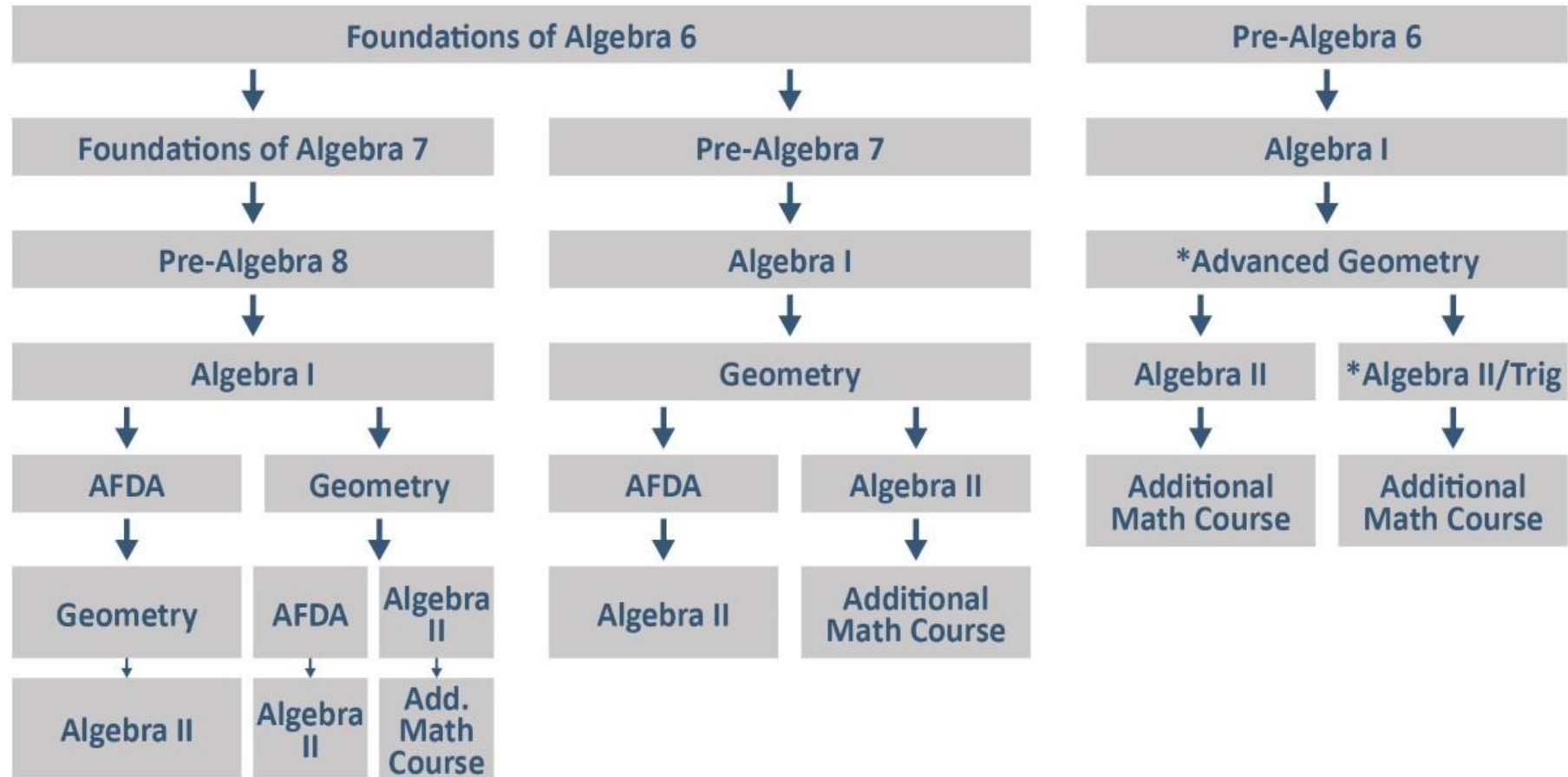
- “A” or mostly "A's"/solid "B" average in 5th grade Math (assessments)

- Explore interests, careers and workplace readiness skills

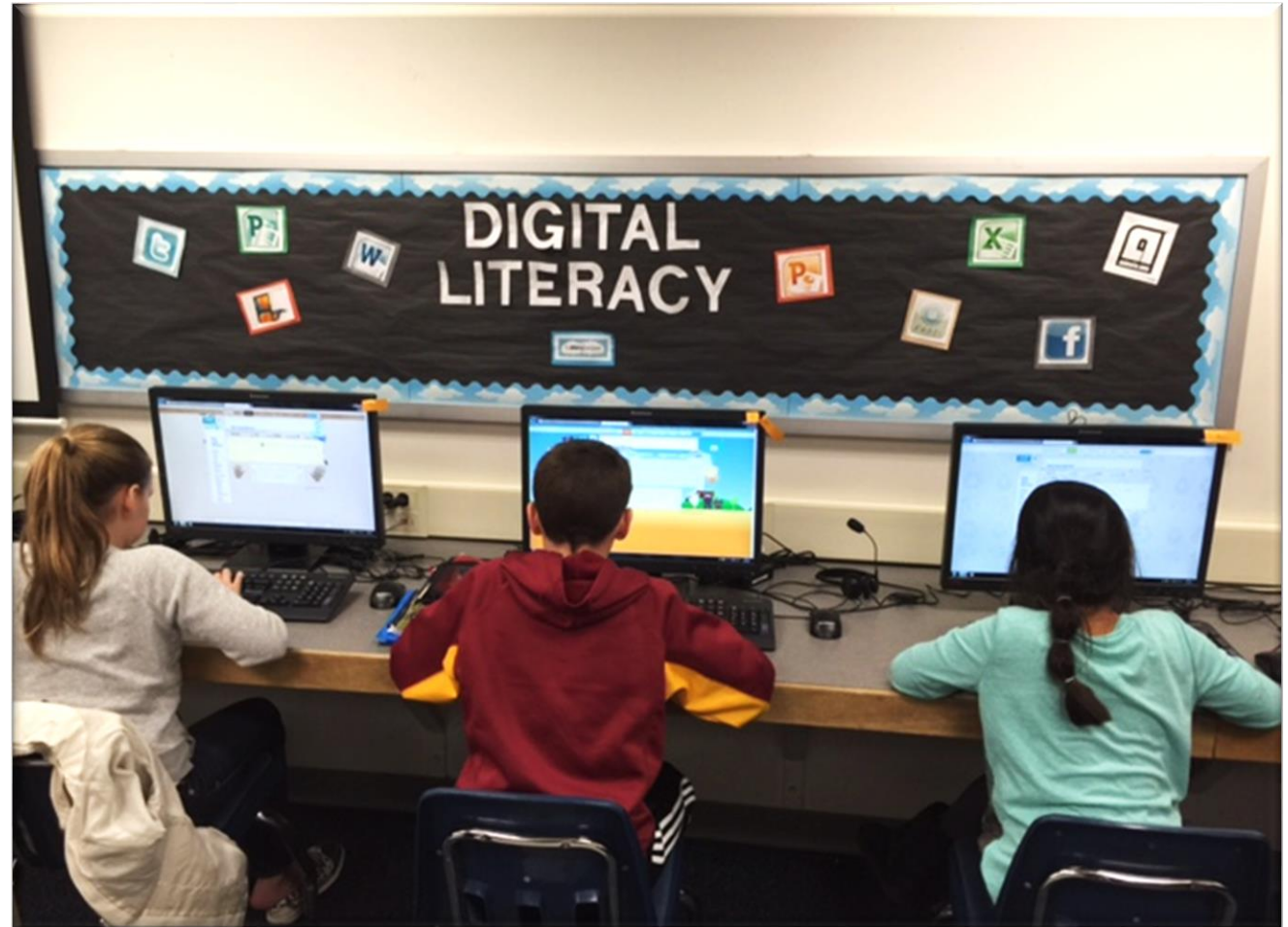
*This course satisfies the VA state requirement for all students to take a middle school career course.

*Students who do not take the wheel in 6th grade will be required to take Career Investigations as a semester long elective in 7th or 8th grade.

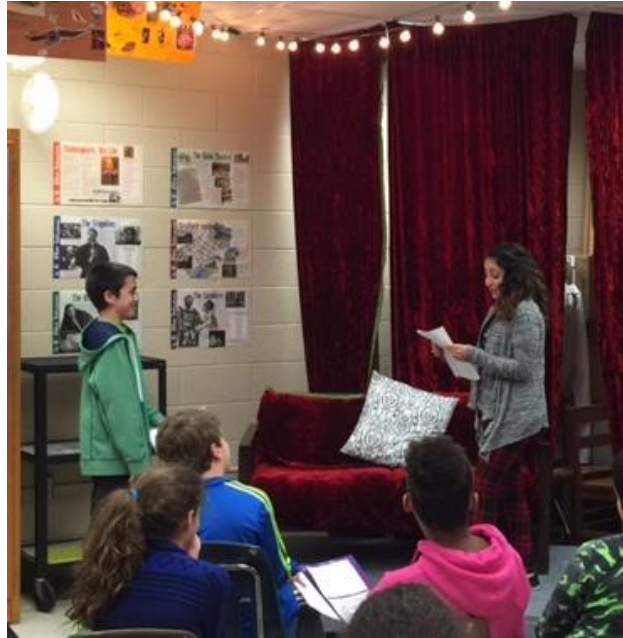

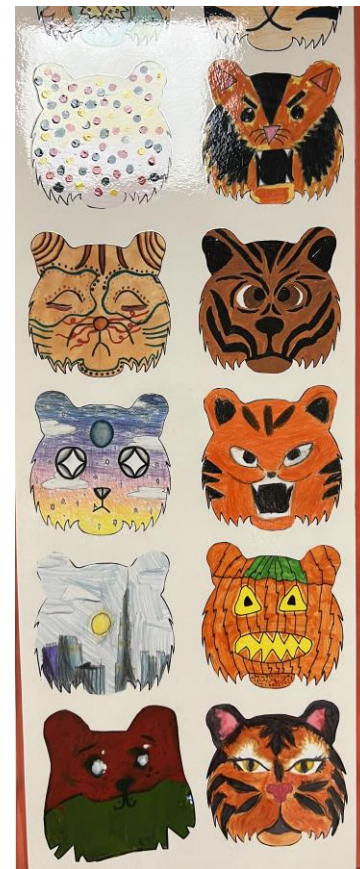

Educational Technology

1:1 Device Program

Students can use their own device or check-out a YCSD issued device

Aspen

Students' schedules, list of teachers, monitor students' official grades, attendance information, emergency contact information

Office 365

Cloud based version of Microsoft Office suite – outlook email for students, word, excel, PowerPoint, etc.

Canvas LMS

Students can see all their class content in one place, including a calendar for due dates, links to class resources like videos, and posted homework assignments. They can turn in assignments and see teacher feedback.

Parents can "observe" their student's progress and performance in each class. (Other YCSD parents have suggested parents use the student Canvas app to monitor student progress).
