Work Study Program Elective Credit	Grades 9 - 12 School Requirement

The work study program, offered by Prairie Creeks High School and participating employers, is designed to provide students with practical, hands-on experience. Throughout the program, students will have the opportunity to collaborate with experienced professionals, explore their interests, and develop essential skills for future career success.

Program Objectives:

1. Gain practical experience in industry
2. Develop professional skills such as communication, teamwork, problem-solving, and time management.
3. Receive mentorship and guidance from experienced professionals in the field.
4. Build a professional network and establish connections for future career opportunities.

Students will meet with the teacher at least one day a week and complete at least 40 hours of work a month.

Managers of employees will be surveyed to discuss the students work and attendance, and grades will be based on that survey. This class is worth up to 1.5 elective credits per semester.
