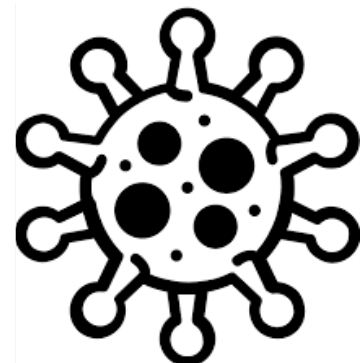



Martin Luther King Day of Service Projects Underway, Extend into Next Week

Student Numbers

- 1 Parent reports case to school nurse
- 2 School nurse verifies case in accordance with NJDOH guidelines
- 3 School nurse reports case to Human Resources Department
- 4 Human Resources Department writes letter of notification to applicable school community
- 5 School principal sends letter to the school community
- 6 All cases for the week are recorded by the nurses on the Dashboard document by 10 am each Friday (cases reported after 10 am are reported in the following week's numbers)

Dashboard is updated every Friday afternoon

Kindergarten Online Pre-Registration Opens 1/18/22

Online pre-registration for kindergarten and new 1st grade students for the 2022-2023 school year will open on January 18, 2022.

Children must be five years old on or before October 1, 2022 to be eligible for kindergarten. Students currently enrolled in the Cherry Hill Public Schools, including the Barclay Early Childhood Center, do not need to re-register.
